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Patterns



Baby Triceratops

Materials:

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: dark-orange, light-orange, tan, black, white, ivory and pastel-pink.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, half double crochet and double crochet.

Finished size:

Height: 7.5 inches tall

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Realization

Head (light-orange color):

The head is crocheted from front to back, starting on the muzzle, and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 16 & 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 19 & 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 22 & 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 24: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 25 & 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (38 stitches)

Rnd 28: 17 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (40 stitches)

Rnd 29: 18 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (42 stitches)

Rnd 30: 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 13 single crochet (46 stitches)

Rnd 31: 17 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 13 single crochet (50 stitches)

Rnd 32 to 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 38: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 39: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 40: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (35 stitches).

Rnd 41: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 42: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 43: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 44: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 45: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 46: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



Body (light-orange color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since next round you're going to start shaping the back's curvature:

Rnd 18: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 18 single crochet, *1 decrease, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (54 stitches)

Rnd 19 & 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 17 single crochet, *1 decrease, 5 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (48 stitches)

Rnd 22 & 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 24: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 16 single crochet, *1 decrease, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (42 stitches)

Rnd 25 & 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 15 single crochet, *1 decrease, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (36 stitches)

Rnd 28 & 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 30: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 14 single crochet, *1 decrease, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (30 stitches)

Rnd 31 & 32: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 33: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 13 single crochet, *1 decrease, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (24 stitches)

Rnd 34 to 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.



Tail and back (dark-orange color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 6 & 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 9 & 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 16 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Now you will start crocheting the dino's back-side in rows back and forth:

Row 19: 18 single crochet.

Row 20: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (20 stitches)

Row 21: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (22 stitches)

Row 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 23: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 16 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (20 stitches)

Row 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 25: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 14 single crochet, 1

decrease, 1 single crochet (18 stitches)

Row 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 27: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 12 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (16 stitches)

Row 28: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 29: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 10 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (14 stitches)

Row 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 31: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (12 stitches)

Row 32: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (10 stitches)

Row 33: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (8 stitches)

Row 34: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (6 stitches)

Row 35 to 39: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 40: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (8 stitches)

Row 41: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (10 stitches)

Row 42: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (12 stitches)

Row 43: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (14 stitches)

Row 44 to 49: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 50: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (12 stitches)

Row 51: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (10 stitches)

Row 52: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (8 stitches)

Row 53: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (6 stitches)

Row 54: 1 single crochet, 2 decreases (2 single crochet closed together twice), 1 single crochet (4 stitches)

Once you finish row 54, work a single crochet round all around the borderline of this piece.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fill the tail with stuffing.



Frill (dark-orange color):

The frill is crocheted in rows back and forth directly over the top and sides of the head over round 37.

Row 1: 35 single crochet.

Row 2: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 7 times (42 stitches).

Row 3: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 7 times (49 stitches).

Row 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

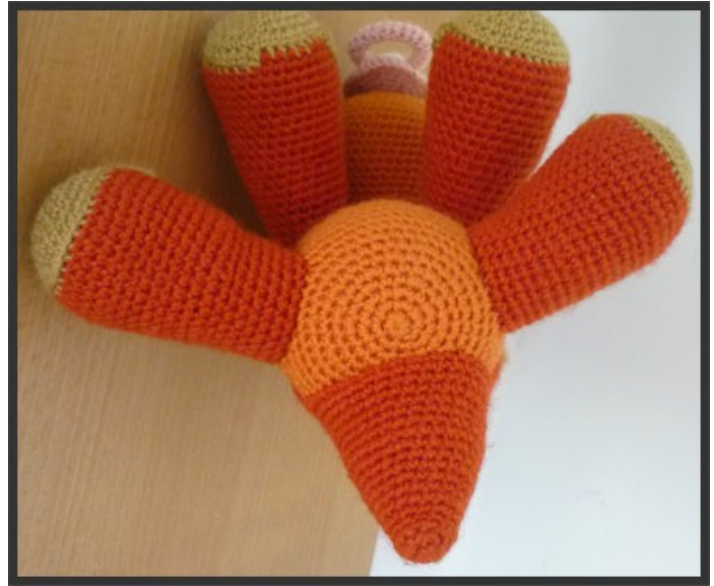
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Insert your hook in the first union stitch between the frill and head, and with tan color crochet around the frill:

*1 single crochet, skip next 2 stitches, 6 double crochet in next stitch, skip next 2 stitches *, repeat until you finish working all frill's borderline, 1 single crochet (10 shells).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Sew the body to the bottom of the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back side.



Sew the tail and back over the back-side of the body, placing the front side of the tail's borderline over round 3 of the body and the back's top borderline matching the frill's first row, as you can see in the upper images.



With tan yarn embroider some spots over the back side of the head, back and tail's tip.



Horns:

Muzzle horn (tan color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches)

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches)

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches)

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches)

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10 stitches)

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (11 stitches)

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches)

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing. Sew the muzzle horn on the tip of the muzzle, behind round 9 of the head.

Forehead horns (tan color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches)

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches)

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches)

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches)

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10 stitches)

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them with stuffing. Sew the forehead horns over the forehead, 2 rounds in front of the frill and with 11 stitches of distance from each other.



Eyes:

Eyeballs (White color):

The eyeballs are crocheted in a single piece and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Work a foundation chain of 5 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single in next stitch (14 stitches)

Rnd 2: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (18 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (22 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 7 times, 1 single crochet (15 stitches).

Rnd 7: 7 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 7 times), 1 single crochet (8 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch on the middle of the back side of the eyeball. Then, wrap the yarn twice around the eyeball in order to divide it in 2 and make another stitch in the back side in order to keep this secure.

With black yarn embroider two pupils (one on each half of eyeball) and with white yarn make a stitch inside the pupils to illuminate them.

Eyelids (light-orange color):

The eyelids are crocheted in a single piece.

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Fold circle in half and join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 18 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Sew the eyeballs centered over the face between rounds 22 and 30. Sew the eyelid to the face by its straight border, placing it around the top and sides of the eyeballs.



With black yarn and chain stitches embroider the mouth around the muzzle as you can see in the upper image.



Forelegs (Make 2):

The forelegs are crocheted from bottom to top and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Tan color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Switch to dark-orange color:

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 19 to 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 24: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 25 to 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 30: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 31 & 32: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 33: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 34: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the body, 3 rounds below the union between head and body.



Backlegs (Make 2):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Tan color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Switch to dark-orange color:

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 20 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them with stuffing.

Sew the back legs to both sides of the body, 12 rounds below the forelegs.

With tan yarn embroider some different-sized spots over the front size of each leg.

Nails (tan color):

Make 4. Work a foundation chain of 13 stitches and crochet:

Row 1: 13 single crochet.

Row 2: 1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 half double crochet, 2 double crochet in next stitch, 1 half double crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 slip stitch, 1 chain stitch, 1 half double crochet, 3 double crochet in next stitch, 1 half double crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 slip stitch, 1 chain stitch, 1 half double crochet, 2 double crochet in next stitch, 1 half double crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 single crochet.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the nails on the front side of the legs, matching their straight border with the border of the legs' tan area.

Pacifier:

The pacifier consists in 3 pieces: superior piece, inferior piece and pacifier's handle.

Superior piece (ivory color):

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 7: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 8: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (30 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Inferior piece (pastel-pink color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (30 stitches).

Once you've finished round 6 of the inferior piece, do not cut the yarn off. Face both pieces, superior and inferior, by their wrong sides and join their borders together with a single crochet round in pastel-pink color:

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (35 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Pacifier's handle (pastel-pink color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Sew the handle to the superior piece of the pacifier, as you can see in the upper image. Sew the pacifier to the triceratop's muzzle.

Ending details

Sew the body to the bottom of the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back side. Sew the tail and back over the back-side of the body, placing the front side of the tail's borderline over round 3 of the body and the back's top borderline matching the frill's first row. With tan yarn embroider some spots over the back side of the head, back and tail's tip.

Sew the muzzle horn on the tip of the muzzle, behind round 9 of the head. Sew the forehead horns over the forehead, 2 rounds in front of the frill and with 11 stitches of distance from each other.

Sew the eyeballs centered over the face between rounds 22 and 30. Sew the eyelid to the face by its straight border, placing it around the top and sides of the eyeballs.

With black yarn and chain stitches embroider the mouth around the muzzle.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the body, 3 rounds below the union between head and body.

Sew the back legs to both sides of the body, 12 rounds below the forelegs.

With tan yarn embroider some different-sized spots over the front size of each leg.

Sew the nails on the front side of the legs, matching their straight border with the border of the legs' tan area.

Sew the handle to the superior piece of the pacifier. Sew the pacifier to the triceratop's muzzle.
