Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: dark-grey, light-grey, white, black and terracotta.

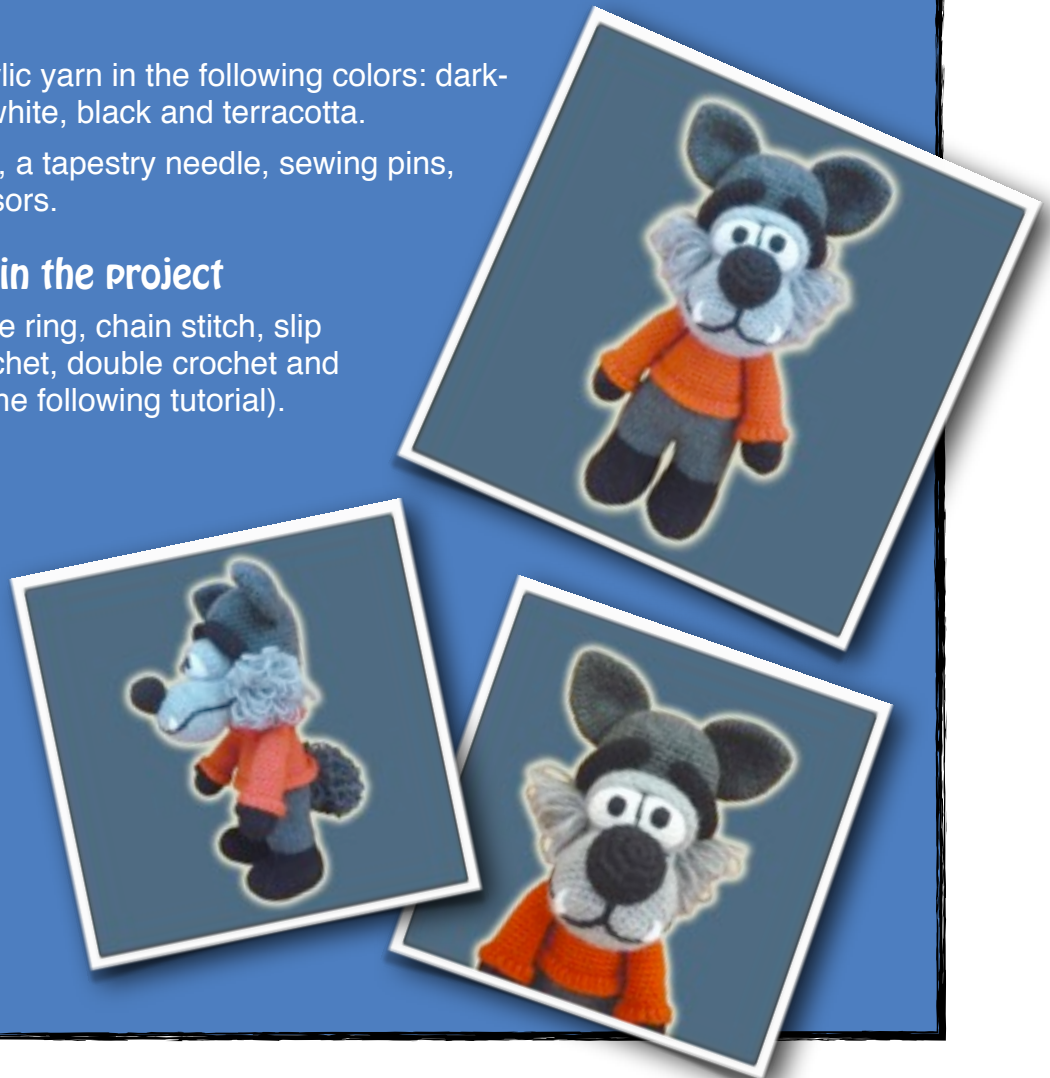
C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, sewing pins, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, double crochet and loop stitch (see the following tutorial).

Finished Size

10.5 inches tall

Tutorial – Loop Stitch

Start with a row (or round) of single crochet stitches.

Step 1:



Insert the hook in the first stitch. Form a loop wrapping the yarn clockwise around your left index finger.

Rotate your hook in the opposite direction from the way you usually would. It goes over the yarn first and then behind both sides of the loop.

Step 2:



Catch both sides of the loop and pass them through the stitch where you inserted the hook in

step 1. Now you'll have the hook in the front side of the work with 3 loops on it and 1 loop in the back side of the work.

Yarn over the hook (you'll have 4 loops on the hook) and pass the strand through the other 3 loops on your hook to finish the stitch.

Step 3:



Repeat steps 1 & 2 till the end of the row.

Realization

Head and Chest:

The head and chest are crochet in a single piece from top to bottom and you have to fill them with stuffing as you go.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Dark-grey color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 28: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 29: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 32: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 33: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 34 to 36: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since next round you will start crocheting the chest. Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 38: Single crochet in each stitch through **BACK LOOPS ONLY**.

Rnd 39: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 40 & 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 42: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 43 & 44: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 45: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 46 & 47: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 48: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 49 & 50: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 51: Double crochet in each stitch through **FRONT LOOPS ONLY**.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Turtle neck (terracotta color):

The turtle neck is crocheted directly on the chest, through the front loops of round 38 and you have to close every round with a slip stitch:

Rnd 1: *3 double crochet, 2 double crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 2 to 5: Crochet without increasing interspersing 1 back post double crochet and 1 front post double crochet in order to get an elastic fabric.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fold the turtle neck towards out.

Legs:

Black color:

Make 2. Work a foundation chain of 16 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet around them:



Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 14 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (36 stitches)

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch * repeat from *to* twice (40 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch * repeat from *to* twice (44 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: 12 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 7 times, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 9: 13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to dark-grey color:

Rnd 15: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 16 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Crochet the other leg following the upper directions. Once you've finished round 20 of the second leg, without cutting the yarn off, join both



legs together with 6 single crochet (crotch) and then continue crocheting the body around the legs:

Rnd 1: 52 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Sew the legs to the chest by their openings, making the stitches from back loops of round 51 of the chest, in order to get the last round of the chest over the lower part of the body.

Muzzle and cheeks (light-grey color):

The muzzle and cheeks are crocheted in a single piece, starting on the muzzle.

Muzzle:

Work a foundation chain of 8 stitches and crochet around:



Rnd 1: 7 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch (20 stitches).

Rnd 2: 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 3: 10 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 4: 11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (34 stitches).

Rnd 5: 13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 2 single crochet (38 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *17 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (36 stitches).

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (32 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (28 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (32 stitches).

Rnd 20: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Crochet 2 extra single crochet and then turn around your work, putting the wrong side of the work facing you in order to start crocheting the cheeks. DO NOT CUT THE YARN OFF.

Cheeks:

The cheeks are crocheted back and forth directly over the last round of the muzzle, **interspersing 1 loop stitch row and 1 single crochet row:**

Row 1: 1 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch, 2 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch, 1 loop stitch (8 stitches).

Row 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 3: 1 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch, 4 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch, 1 loop stitch (10 stitches).

Row 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 5: 1 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch, 6 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch, 1 loop stitch (12 stitches).

Row 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 7: 1 loop stitch, 1 decrease (2 loop stitch closed together), 6 loop stitch, 1 decrease, 1 loop stitch (10 stitches).

Row 8: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (8 stitches).

Row 9: 1 loop stitch, 1 decrease (2 loop stitch closed together), 2 loop stitch, 1 decrease, 1 loop stitch (6 stitches).

Row 10: 1 single crochet, 2 decreases (2 single crochet closed together twice), 1 single crochet (4 stitches).

Row 11: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Crochet the other cheek following the upper instructions, starting it with the wrong side of your work facing you in order to get the loops over the right side and leaving between them 13 stitches of distance on superior and inferior border of the muzzle. Once you finished the second cheek, crochet a single crochet round all around the muzzle and cheeks. Fill the muzzle with stuffing.

With sewing pins, place the muzzle over the front side of the head, centered regarding the feet and with its superior border under round 19 and inferior border



on round 31. Then, pull the cheeks a bit, in a straight line around the head and fix their positions with sewing pins. Sew muzzle and cheeks all around with invisible stitches.

Nose (black color):

The nose has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).



Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the nose centered on the tip of the muzzle, between rounds 4 and 7. With black yarn and a tapestry needle, embroider the mouth in chain stitch. Then, with white yarn, embroider 2 sharp teeth, one on each side of the mouth, like in the final project.

Eyes:

Eyeballs (White color):

The eyeballs are crocheted in a single piece. Work a foundation chain of 10 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 8 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (24 stitches).

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 8 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 8: 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 2 double decreases, 6 single crochet, 1 double decrease (16 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors. Fill with stuffing and sew the borderline together. Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch on the middle of the back side of the eyeball. Wrap the yarn twice around the eyeball in order to divide it in 2 and make another stitch in the back side in order to keep this secure. Then, with black yarn embroider two pupils, one on each half of eyeball.

Eyelids (light-grey color):

The eyelids are crocheted in a single piece.

Work a foundation chain of 10 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 8 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (24 stitches).

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 16 stitches.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyebrows (black color):

Make 2. The eyebrows have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).



Rnd 3 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: 4 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 4 times) (4 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the eyeballs to the face, over the superior border of the muzzle. Place the eyelids a little bit over the eyeballs, and sew their back side to the head and their sides to the muzzle. Sew the eyebrows diagonally above the eyes.

Ears (dark-grey color):



Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch

Rnd 8: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Join the borders with a single crochet row of 12 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the ears by their inferior borders to the tip of the head, between rounds 4 and 14.

Arms (Make 2):

The arms are crocheted from bottom to top and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Black color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 9 single crochet, 4 double crochet closed together in next stitch, 8 single crochet (18 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch through **BACK LOOPS ONLY**.

Rnd 11: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rbd 12 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 18 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 24 to 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sleeve cuffs (terracotta color):



The sleeve cuffs are crocheted directly over the arms, across front loops of round 10:

Rnd 1: 18 Double crochet.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with terracotta yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of the arm, on round 26. Then, pass the needle through the chest from side to side on



1 round below the turtle neck base, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

Tail:

The tail is crocheted from tip to base. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Light-grey color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 loop stitch in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Switch to dark-grey color:



Rnd 6 to 14: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Fill the tail with stuffing and join the borders together with a single crochet row of 9 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the tail by its base to the back side of the body, underneath the lower border of the sweater.

Ending details

Sew the legs to the chest by their openings, making the stitches from back loops of round 51 of the chest, in order to get the last round of the chest over the lower part of the body.

With sewing pins, place the muzzle over the front side of the head, centered regarding the feet and with its superior border under round 19 and inferior border on round 31. Then, pull the cheeks a bit, in a straight line around the head and fix their positions with sewing pins. Sew muzzle and cheeks all around with invisible stitches.

Sew the nose centered on the tip of the muzzle, between rounds 4 and 7. With back yarn and a tapestry needle, embroider the mouth in chain stitch. Then, with white yarn, embroider 2 sharp teeth, one on each side of the mouth, like in the final project.

Sew the eyeballs to the face, over the superior border of the muzzle. Place the eyelids a little bit over the eyeballs, and sew their back side to the head and their sides to the muzzle. Sew the eyebrows diagonally above the eyes.

Sew the ears by their inferior borders to the tip of the head, between rounds 4 and 14.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with terracotta yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of the arm, on round 26. Then, pass the needle through the chest from side to side on 1 round below the turtle neck base, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

Sew the tail by its base to the back side of the body, underneath the lower border of the sweater.
