### Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: lilac, purple, yellow, pink, black and white.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing, colored sewing pins and scissors.

### Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet and popcorn stitch (of 5 double crochet)..

### Finished Size

Height: 6.5 inches  
(wings not included)

Length: 19 inches

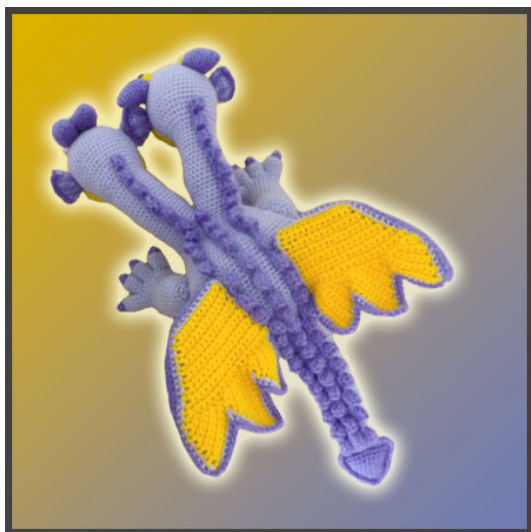
# Realization:

## Body (lilac color):

The body is crocheted in a single piece, from heads to tail, and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

## Head (make 2):

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):



Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 10 & 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 13 & 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (38 stitches).

Rnd 16: 17 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (40 stitches).

Rnd 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: 18 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (42 stitches).

Rnd 19: Single crochet in each stitch

Rnd 20: 19 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (44 stitches).

Rnd 21 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 26: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (35 stitches).

Rnd 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 30: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 31: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 32: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 33 to 52: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**Crochet the 2nd head following the above instructions. Once you finished round 52 of the second head, do not cut the yarn off. Crochet 6 extra single crochet stitches and then, join both heads together with 7 single crochet stitches. Continue crocheting the body around both heads:**

Rnd 1: 36 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 10: \*9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 11: \*10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (72 stitches).

Rnd 12: \*11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (78 stitches).

Rnd 13: \*12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (84 stitches).

Rnd 14 to 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: \*12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (78 stitches).

Rnd 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: \*11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (72 stitches).

Rnd 28: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 29: \*10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 32: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 33: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 34: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 35: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 36: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 37 to 40: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 41: \*10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (33 stitches).

Rnd 42 to 45: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 46: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 47 to 50: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 51: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (27 stitches).

Rnd 52 to 55: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 56: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 57 to 60: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 61: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (21 stitches).

Rnd 62 to 65: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 66: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 67 to 70: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 71: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 72: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

## Ventral Body Piece (yellow color):

This piece is crocheted from heads to tail.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 10 & 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 13 & 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 16 to 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 21 & 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 24 & 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 26: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

**Join the borderline with a single crochet row of 9 stitches and then, continue crocheting back and forth:**

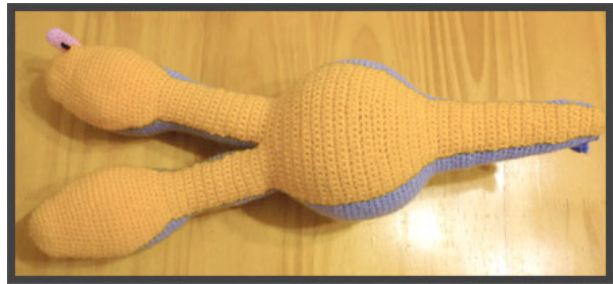
Row 1: 9 single crochet.

Row 2 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**Crochet a 2nd piece following the above instructions. Once you finished row 20 of the second piece, do not cut the yarn off. Continue crocheting the ventral body piece over both pieces:**

Row 1: 18 single crochet.



Row 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 3: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (20 stitches).

Row 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 6: 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet (22 stitches).

Row 7 & 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 9: 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet (24 stitches).

Row 10 to 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 20: 9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (22 stitches)

Row 21 & 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 23: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (20 stitches)

Row 24 & 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 26: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 14 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (18 stitches)

Row 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 28: 5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet, 1 decrease, 5 single crochet (16 stitches)

Row 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 30: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 10 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (14 stitches)

Row 31: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 32: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (12 stitches)

Row 33: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (10 stitches)

Row 34 to 38: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 39: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet (9 stitches)

Row 40 to 44: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 45: 3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet (8 stitches)

Row 46 to 50: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 51: 3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 3 single crochet (7 stitches)

Row 52 to 56: Single crochet in each stitch.



Row 57: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (5 stitches)

Row 58 to 62: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 63: 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (3 stitches)

Row 64: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### Tongue (pink color):

Into a double adjustable ring, crochet:

Rnd 1: 7 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Join the borderline with a single crochet of 3 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



With black yarn embroider a vertical line across the middle of the tongue, from its centre to its superior borderline, in order to divide it in 2.

Sew the tongue underneath the left side of the left head.

Place the ventral body piece along the front side of the body and sew it all around.

### Eyes:

#### Right Head

#### Eyeballs (yellow color):

Make 2. The eyeballs have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 6: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).



Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

#### Eyelids (purple color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (9 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Over the front side of the eyeballs, with black yarn, embroider the pupils in an oval shape. With white color embroider on each pupil a small dot to illuminate them. Sew the eyelids by their openings to the tip of the eyeballs.

Sew the eyeballs to the right head's face, placing them above round 12 and leaving 5 stitches of distance between them.

#### Left Head: Eyeballs (yellow color):

The eyeballs are crocheted in a single piece and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.



Work a foundation chain of 5 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single in next stitch (14 stitches)

Rnd 2: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 7 times, 1 single crochet (15 stitches).

Rnd 7: 7 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 7 times), 1 single crochet (8 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch on the middle of the back side of the eyeball. Wrap the yarn twice around the





eyeball in order to divide it in 2 and make another stitch in the back side in order to keep this secure.

Then, over the front side of the eyeballs and with black yarn, embroider the pupils in an oval shape. With white color embroider on each pupil a small dot to illuminate them.

### **Eyelids (purple color):**

The eyelids are crocheted in a single piece.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (9 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**Crochet a second piece following the above instructions. Once you finished round 6 of the second piece, do not cut the yarn off. Sew the borderlines of both pieces together in 1 stitch and then, continue crocheting the eyelids around them:**

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing. Sew the eyelids to the tip of the eyeballs by its opening. With black yarn mark the division between the eyeballs (as you did with the eyeballs).

Sew the eyeballs to the left head's face, placing them centered and above round 9.

### **Head's side membranes (Make 4):**

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

#### **Lilac Color:**

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

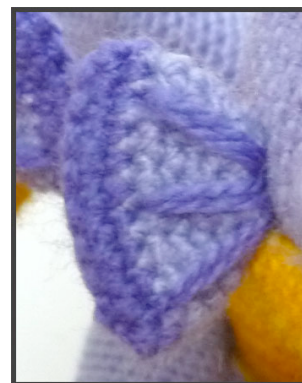
Rnd 6: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (20 stitches).

#### **Switch to purple color:**

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 10 stitches.

On each membrane, with purple yarn embroider 3 lines to divide the surface in 4, as you can see in the image. Sew the side membranes to both sides of both heads.



### Nostrils (lilac color):

Make 4. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 5 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the nostrils to the tip of both muzzles.

### Dorsal scale rows (purple color):

The 3 dorsal scale rows are crocheted directly over the dragon's back (though, if you prefer, you can crochet them separately and then sew them on). The side scale rows go from the tip of the tail to the back of the head (round 28 of the head), while the central scale row goes from the tip of the tail to the union between the necks.

First, with some yarn of any color and colored sewing pins, mark on the dragon's back 3 longitudinal rows to use as reference for placing the scale rows. Then, starting on the tail's tip, crochet:



### Side scale rows (make 2):

Row 1: 94 single crochet.

Row 2: \*1 popcorn stitch (of 5 double crochet), skip the next 3 stitches, 1 slip stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 23 times (23 scales).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



### Central scale row:

Row 1: 70 single crochet.

Row 2: \*1 popcorn stitch (of 5 double crochet), skip the next 3 stitches, 1 slip stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 17 times (17 scales).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### Tail Spade (Purple color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Fill it slightly with stuffing. Crochet 2 single crochet rounds along the spade borders, closing the spade opening by joining together its inferior borders and working a double increase on each corner.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the tail spade to the tip of the dragon's tail.



## Wings:

### Superior Border (purple color):

Make 2. The superior borders are crocheted from top to bottom and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.



Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 8 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 44: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### Wing Membranes (yellow color):

Make 2. Work a foundation chain of 12 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet:

Row 1: 12 single crochet.

Row 2: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (13 stitches).

Row 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 4: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (14 stitches).

Row 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 6: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (15 stitches).

Row 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 8: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (16 stitches).

Row 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 10: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (17 stitches).

Row 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 12: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (18 stitches).

Row 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Since next row you will start crocheting the wing tips:**

Row 14: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 slip stitch (3 stitches).

Row 15: Single crochet in each stitch (3 stitches).

Row 16: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 2 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (5 stitches).

Row 17: Single crochet in each stitch (5 stitches).

Row 18: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 4 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (7 stitches).

Row 19: Single crochet in each stitch (7 stitches).

Row 20: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 6 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (9 stitches).

Row 21: Single crochet in each stitch (9 stitches).

Row 22: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (12 stitches).

Row 23: 3 single crochet.

Row 24: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 2 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (5 stitches).

Row 25: Single crochet in each stitch (5 stitches).

Row 26: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 4 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (7 stitches).

Row 27: Single crochet in each stitch (7 stitches).

Row 28: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 6 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (9 stitches).

Row 29: Single crochet in each stitch (9 stitches).

Row 30: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 8 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (11 stitches).

Row 31: Single crochet in each stitch (11 stitches).



Row 32: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 11 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (14 stitches).

Row 33: 3 single crochet.

Row 34: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 2 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (5 stitches).

Row 35: Single crochet in each stitch (5 stitches).

Row 36: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 4 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (7 stitches).

Row 37: Single crochet in each stitch (7 stitches).

Row 38: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 6 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (9 stitches).

Row 39: Single crochet in each stitch (9 stitches).



Row 40: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (12 stitches).

Switch to **lilac color** and work a single crochet round along the wing membrane's border, closing the round with a slip stitch. Then, switch to **purple color** and crochet a second single crochet round along the wing membrane's border. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the superior border to the wing membrane.

Sew the wings to the back side of the dragon, matching their straight border with the bottom of side scales rows.

## Forelegs (Make 2):

The forelegs are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the toes and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

### Toes (Make 4 per leg):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:



### Purple color:

Rnd 1: 4 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (5 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (6 stitches).

### Switch to lilac color:

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches)

Rnd 5 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**Crochet the other 3 toes following the above instructions. Once you finished crocheting the 4th toe, do not cut the yarn off. Place 1 toe next to each other and sew them together by 5 stitches. Then, continue crocheting the foot around the toes, starting on the side of the last toe:**

Rnd 1: 26 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 6 & 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Crochet 5 extra single crochet stitches and start crocheting the heel, back and forth:**

Row 1: 4 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (5 stitches).

Row 2: 5 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (6 stitches).

Row 3: 6 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (7 stitches).

Row 4: 7 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (8 stitches).

Row 5: 8 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (9 stitches).



Row 6: 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (10 stitches).  
Row 7: 10 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (11 stitches).  
Row 8: 11 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (12 stitches).  
Row 9: 12 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (13 stitches).  
Row 10: 13 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (14 stitches).

**From next round, continue crocheting the leg in spiral:**

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 19: : Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 21: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 22: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

## Hind legs (Make 2):

The hind legs are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the toes, and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

### Toes (Make 4 per leg):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

#### Purple color:

Rnd 1: 4 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (5 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (6 stitches).

#### Switch to lilac color:

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches)

Rnd 5 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**Crochet the other 3 toes following the above instructions. Once you finished crocheting the 4th toe, do not cut the yarn off. Place 1 toe next to each other and sew them together by 5 stitches. Then, continue crocheting the foot around the toes, starting on the side of the last toe:**

Rnd 1: 26 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 6 & 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Crochet 5 extra single crochet stitches and start crocheting the heel, back and forth:**

Row 1: 4 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (5 stitches).

Row 2: 5 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (6 stitches).  
Row 3: 6 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (7 stitches).  
Row 4: 7 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (8 stitches).  
Row 5: 8 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (9 stitches).  
Row 6: 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (10 stitches).  
Row 7: 10 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (11 stitches).  
Row 8: 11 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (12 stitches).  
Row 9: 12 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (13 stitches).  
Row 10: 13 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (14 stitches).

**From next round, continue crocheting the leg in spiral:**

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 20: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 21: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 22: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the body, 5 rounds behind the neck's bottom and with their superior borders halfway up the body.

Sew the hind legs to both sides of the body leaving 6 stitches of distance between the forelegs and them.



# Ending details:

With black yarn embroider a vertical line across the middle of the tongue, from its centre to its superior borderline, in order to divide it in 2.



Sew the tongue underneath the left side of the left head.

Place the ventral body piece along the front side of the body and sew it all around.

Sew the separated eyeballs to the right head's face, placing them above round 12 and leaving 5 stitches of distance between them.

Sew the single piece eyeballs to the left head's face, placing them centered and above round 9.

Sew the side membranes to both sides of both heads and sew the nostrils to the tip of both muzzles.

Sew the tail spade

to the tip of the dragon's tail.

Sew the wings to the back side of the dragon, matching their straight border with the bottom of side scales rows.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the body, 5 rounds behind the neck's bottom and with their superior borders halfway up the body.

Sew the hind legs to both sides of the body leaving 6 stitches of distance between the forelegs and them.
