

## Moe, The Mammoth

### Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: tan, brown, dark-brown, black, white and pink.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

### Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet and loop stitch (see the following tutorial).

### Finished Size

7 inches tall

11 inches long (trunk is not included)



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# Tutorial – Loop Stitch

Start with a row (or round) of single crochet stitches.

## Step 1:



Insert the hook in the first stitch. Form a loop wrapping the yarn clockwise around your left index finger.

Rotate your hook in the opposite direction from the way you usually would. It goes over the yarn first and then behind both sides of the loop.

## Step 2:



Catch both sides of the loop and pass them through the stitch where you inserted the hook in

step 1. Now you'll have the hook in the front side of the work with 3 loops on it and 1 loop in the back side of the work.

Yarn over the hook (you'll have 4 loops on the hook) and pass the strand through the other 3 loops on your hook to finish the stitch.

### Step 3:



Repeat steps 1 & 2 till the end of the row.

## Realization

### Face:

The face is crocheted from front to back, starting on the trunk.

#### **Pink color:**



Work a foundation chain of 4 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (10 stitches).

Rnd 2: \*4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (14 stitches).

#### **Switch to tan color:**

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 4 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet (16 stitches).

Rnd 15 to 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 19 to 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 22: 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (20 stitches).

Rnd 23 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 26: \*9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 27 to 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Since next row start crocheting back and forth in order to bend the trunk:**

Row 1: 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (10 stitches).

Row 2: 3 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (4 stitches).

Row 3: 5 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (6 stitches).

Row 4: 7 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (8 stitches).

Row 5: 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (10 stitches).

Row 6: 11 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (12 stitches).

**From next round start crocheting in a continuous spiral:**

Rnd 1: 22 single crochet.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 16 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet (26 stitches).

Rnd 6: 3 single crochet, \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 13 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 7: 4 single crochet, \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 13 single crochet (34 stitches).

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 24 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Switch to brown color:**

Rnd 21: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.



## Hair (dark-brown color):

The hair is crocheted interspersing single crochet rounds (odd round) and loop stitch rounds (pair round) and has to be filled with stuffing as you go. When you crochet the loop stitch rounds, you have to extend the loops a bit.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 loop stitches in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 8: \*3 loop stitch, 1 decrease (2 loop stitches closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 10: \*1 loop stitch, 1 decrease (2 loop stitches closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 11: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

## Eyes:

### Eyeballs (White color):

The eyeballs are crocheted in a single piece. Work a foundation chain of 10 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 8 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (24 stitches).

Rnd 2: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 8 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 8: 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 2 double decreases, 6 single crochet, 1 double decrease (16 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors. Fill with stuffing and sew the borderline together.

Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch on the middle of the back side of the eyeball. Wrap the yarn twice around the eyeball in order to divide it in 2 and make another stitch in the back side to keep this secure. Then, with black yarn embroider two pupils, one on each half of eyeball.

### Eyelids (brown color):

The eyelids are crocheted in a single piece.

Work a foundation chain of 10 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 8 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (24 stitches).

Rnd 2: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Place the eyeballs inside the eyelids, with their superior border right above the pupils and sew all around (but not through the eyelids border).



### Body (brown color):

The body is crocheted from front to back as has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Work a foundation chain of 6 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet around:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet, 5 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch (18 stitches).

Rnd 2: \*6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 3: 7 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (34 stitches).

Rnd 4: 8 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (42 stitches).

Rnd 5: 9 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 12 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet, 3 single



crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet (50 stitches).

**Since next round start interspersing 1 loop stitch round (pair round) and 1 single crochet round (odd round):**

Rnd 6: \*9 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (55 stitches).

Rnd 7: \*10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 8: \*11 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (65 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (70 stitches).

Rnd 10: \*13 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (75 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 14: Crochet without increasing, interspersing single crochet rounds (odd round) and loop stitch rounds (pair round).

Rnd 15: \*13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (70 stitches).

Rnd 16: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 17: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 18: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 19: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (50 stitches).

Rnd 20: \*4 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (total 60 puntos).

Rnd 21: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (70 stitches).

Rnd 22: \*6 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (80 stitches).

Rnd 23: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (90 stitches).

Rnd 24: \*8 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (100 stitches).

**Start crocheting back and forth, rotating your work to get the loop stitch on the right side of your work:**

Row 1: 22 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (23 stitches).

Row 2: 12 loop stitch, 1 slip stitch (13 stitches).

Row 3: 14 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (15 stitches).

Row 4: 16 loop stitch, 1 slip stitch (17 stitches).

Row 5: 18 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (19 stitches).

Row 6: 20 loop stitch, 1 slip stitch (21 stitches).

Row 7: 22 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (23 stitches).

Row 8: 24 loop stitch, 1 slip stitch (25 stitches).

**Since next round start crocheting in a continuous spiral, interspersing 1 single crochet round (odd round) and 1 loop stitch round (pair round):**

Rnd 1: 100 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 3: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (90 stitches).

Rnd 4: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (80 stitches).

Rnd 6: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 7: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (70 stitches).

Rnd 8: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 9: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 10: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 11: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 10 times (50 stitches).

Rnd 12: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 13: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 14: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 17: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 18: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 21: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (35 stitches).

Rnd 22: Loop stitch in each stitch.

Rnd 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 24: Loop stitch in each stitch.



Rnd 25: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 26: \*3 loop stitch, 1 decrease (2 loop stitches closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (total 24 puntos).

Rnd 27: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (total 18 puntos).

Rnd 28: \*1 loop stitch, 1 decrease (2 loop stitches closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 times).

Rnd 29: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).



Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



Sew the face by its opening to the single crochet rectangle of the body placed between rounds 1 and 9, adding extra stuffing if needed.

Over the top of the face and next to its union with the body, sew the



hair. Then, in front of the hair, sew the eyes.

With black yarn embroider the nostrils on to tip of the trunk and the mouth, as shown on the images.

## Tusks (Make 2):

The tusks are crocheted from tip to bottom and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

**White color:**

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches).

Rnd 5 & 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches).

Rnd 8 & 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches).

Rnd 11 & 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches).

Rnd 14 & 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10 stitches).

Rnd 17 & 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (11 stitches).

Rnd 20 & 21: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 22: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches).

Rnd 23 to 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Switch to tan color:**

Rnd 27 to 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the tusks to both sides of the face by their bases, 2 rounds in front of the face's union with the body.

### **Legs (make 4):**

The legs are crocheted from bottom to top and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

**Dark-brown color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

### **Switch to brown color:**

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 8 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 14 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 20 to 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 28: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

## **Nails (Make 4):**

With **tan** color yarn work a foundation chain of 13 stitches, and on them crochet:

Row 1: 13 single crochet.

Row 2: 1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 half double crochet, 2 double crochet in next stitch, 1 half double crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 slip stitch, 1 chain stitch, 1 half double crochet, 3 double crochet in next stitch, 1 half double crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 slip stitch, 1 chain stitch, 1 half double crochet, 2 double crochet in next stitch, 1 half double crochet, 1 chain stitch, 1 single crochet.

### **Switch to dark-brown color and crochet all around the nails:**

Rnd 1: 21 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting your hook 2 rows below, 6 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting your hook 2 rows below, 6 single crochet (close the round with a slip stitch).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Sew the nails on the front side of the legs, matching their straight border with the border of the legs' dark-brown area.



To assemble the front legs to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with brown yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of 1 leg, between rounds 23 and 24. Then, pass the needle through

body, from side to side, 1 inch away from its union with the face, pulling the yarn tight in order to get the front leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other front leg.

The procedure for assembling the hind legs is the same used for the front legs, but you'll need to pass the needle through the back side of the body, from side to side, 2.5 inches away from the front leg.

### Ears (Make 2):

With **brown** yarn make a double adjustable ring and crochet:

Rnd 1: 3 **brown** single crochet, 3 **tan** single crochet (6 stitches).

Rnd 2: 2 **brown** single crochet in each **brown** stitch from last round, 2 **tan** single crochet in each tan stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 **brown** single crochet, 2 **brown** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; \*1 **tan** single crochet, 2 **tan** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 **brown** single crochet, 2 **brown** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; \*2 **tan** single crochet, 2 **tan** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 **brown** single crochet, 2 **brown** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; \*3 **tan** single crochet, 2 **tan** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 **brown** single crochet, 2 **brown** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; \*4 **tan** single crochet, 2 **tan** single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times (36 stitches).

**Switch to brown color:**





Rnd 7: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

**Fold the circle in half (you'll get 1 tan semicircle in the front and 1 brown semicircle in the back) and join the borders crocheting:**

Row 1: 21 single crochet.

Row 2: \*1 single crochet, 1 half double crochet, 4 double crochet in next stitch, 1 half double crochet\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times, 9 single crochet (30 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**IMPORTANT: When you crochet the other ear, don't forget to switch this row's order (meaning that you'll need to start crocheting 9 single crochet and then the shells) in order to get the 3 shells on the bottom of both ears.**

Sew the ears to both sides of the head behind the union between the face and body and with their tan areas to the front and the 3 shells on bottom.

### Tail (brown color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:



Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches).

Rnd 5 & 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches).

Rnd 8 & 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches).

Rnd 11 & 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches).

Rnd 14 & 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round

(10 stitches).

Rnd 17 & 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 5 stitches (do not stuff the tail).

Sew some dark-brown yarn as tuft on the tip of the tail.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body.

# Ending details



Sew the face by its opening to the single crochet rectangle of the body placed between rounds 1 and 9, adding extra stuffing if needed.

Over the top of the face and next to its union with the body, sew the hair. Then, in front of the hair, sew the eyes.

With black yarn embroider the nostrils on to tip of the trunk and the mouth.

Sew the tusks to both sides of the face by their bases, 2 rounds in front of the face's union with the body.

Sew the nails on the front side of the legs, matching their straight border with the border of the legs' dark-brown area.

To assembly the front legs to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with brown yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of 1 leg, between rounds 23 and 24. Then, pass the needle through body, from side to side, 1 inch away from its union with the face, pulling the yarn tight in order to get the front leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other front leg.

The procedure for assembling the hind legs is the same used for the front legs, but you'll need to pass the needle through the back side of the body, from side to side, 2.5 inches away from the front leg.

Sew the ears to both sides of the head behind the union between the face and body and with their tan areas to the front and the 3 shells on bottom.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body.
