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Patterns



Panda Bears

Materials:

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: black, white and brown.
C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing, scissors and orange/ turquoise ribbons

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, single crochet and half double crochet.

Finished size:

Papa Bear: 10.5 inches (standing); 8.5 inches (sitting).

Baby Bear: 6 inches (standing); 4.9 inches (sitting)

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Realization

Papa Bear:

Head (White color):

The head is crocheted from front to back, starting on the muzzle and it has to be stuffed as you go. To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: 22 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 22 single crochet (50 stitches).

Rnd 16: 20 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 19 single crochet (55 stitches).

Rnd 17: 21 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 19 single crochet (60 stitches).

Rnd 18: 10 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 17 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet (66 stitches).

Rnd 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: 11 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 18 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet (72 stitches).

Rnd 21 to 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 32: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 33: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 34: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 35: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 36: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 37: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 38: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 39: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times

(30 stitches).

Rnd 40: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 41: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 42: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 43: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and with it mark the eye orbits like this: Push the needle inside the head on round 15 and through inside go from side to side of the head taking the needle out in the same round but 14 stitches away from the spot where you introduce it first. Pull the yarn a bit and repeat the procedure twice.

Eye Patches (black color):

Make 2. Work a foundation chain of 8 stitches (don't close them in a round) and crochet around them:

Rnd 1: 7 single crochet, 5 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (20 stitches)

Rnd 2: 7 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* 5 times, 7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (26 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 7 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (33 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Sew the eye patches to the face, with their wider side towards down and matching their internal border with round 15 of the head.

Nose (black color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 7: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 decrease*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.



Sew the nose to the tip of the muzzle. Then, with black yarn and chain stitches embroider the mouth as you can see in the upper image.



Eyes (Make 2):

The eyes are crocheted from front to back and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

White color:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Switch to black color:

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 6: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



With black yarn and chain stitches embroider a round over the color exchange between black and White. Then, over the internal half of the eye's front side embroider the pupil with black color and the iris with Brown color (the iris is a chain stitch row over the external edge of the pupil). Finally, with white yarn embroider 2 light points inside the pupils.

Sew the eyes to both sides of the muzzle, vertically centered over the black patches of the face.

Ears (black color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Join the inferior borders together with a single crochet row of 12 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the ears to the tip of the head over round 28 and leaving 12 stitches of distance between them.



Body:

The body is crocheted from bottom to top. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

White color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since next round you're going to start shaping the back's curvature:

Rnd 19: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 18 single crochet, *1 decrease, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (54 stitches)

Rnd 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 17 single crochet, *1 decrease, 5 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (48 stitches)

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 16 single crochet, *1 decrease, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (42 stitches)

Rnd 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 3 times, 15 single crochet, *1 decrease, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (36 stitches)

Rnd 26 to 28: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to black color:

Rnd 29 to 31: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 32: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 33 to 35: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing. Sew the body to the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back.



Legs (black color):

Make 2. The legs are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the foot soles and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Work a foundation chain of 16 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:
Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 14 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (36 stitches)

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (40 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (44 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: 12 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 7 times, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 9: 13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 30: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 31: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

In order to assemble the legs to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the leg, on round 28. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side between rounds 11 & 12, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other leg.

Arms (black color):

Make 2. The arms are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the hands and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: 10 single crochet, 2 double decreases (3 single crochet closed together twice), 10 single crochet (22 stitches).

Rnd 15 to 34: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 35: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 36: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 37: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 38: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the arm, on round 35. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 32, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

With white yarn mark the toes and fingers on as in the final Project.



Tail (White color):

The tail has to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 6: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the tail to the back side of the body.

Baby Bear:

Head (white color):

The head is crocheted from front to back, starting on the muzzle and has to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: 11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 11 single crochet (26 stitches)

Rnd 10: 12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet (28 stitches).

Rnd 11: 9 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet (34 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: 15 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (32 stitches).

Rnd 18: 14 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 8 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 19: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 20: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 21: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times

(12 stitches).

Rnd 22: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Texto



Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and with it mark the eye orbits like this: Push the needle inside the head between rounds 9 & 10 and through inside go from side to side of the head taking the needle out in the same round but 8 stitches away from the spot where you introduce it first. Pull the yarn a bit and repeat the procedure twice. Then, with black yarn embroider the nose and mouth as in the upper image.

Eye Patches (black color):

Make 2. Work a foundation chain of 4 stitches (don't close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

3 half double crochet, 5 half double crochet in next stitch, 3 half double crochet. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the eye patches to the face matching their internal border with round 9 of the head.

Eyes (White color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 4 single crochet.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With black yarn embroider the pupils over the centre of the eyes and with white yarn embroider a small mark inside the pupils. Sew the eyes to the face vertically centered over the eye patches.

Ears (black color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the ears to the tip of the head over round 16 and leaving 6 stitches of distance between them.

Body:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

White color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since next round you're going to start shaping the back's curvature:

Rnd 12: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 13: 9 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (27 stitches)

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: 8 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (24 stitches)

Switch to black color:

Rnd 16 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 20: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.



Sew the body to the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back.

Legs (black color):

Make 2. The legs are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the foot soles, and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Work a foundation chain of 6 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (14 stitches)

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 3: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (22 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: 8 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 7 single crochet (18 stitches)

Rnd 7: 7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (16 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 4 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 18: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



In order to assemble the legs to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the leg, between round 15 & 16. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side between rounds 6 & 7, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other leg.



Arms (black colors):

Make 2. The arms are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the hands and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 6 single crochet, 1 triple decrease (4 single crochet closed together), 5 single crochet (12 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the arm, on round 18. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 18, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

With white yarn mark the toes and fingers on as in the final Project.

Tail (White color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Put a bit of stuffing in the centre of the tail and then with the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close. Sew the tail to the back side of the body.



Ending details

Papa Bear:

On the head, in order to mark the eye orbits, thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and do as following:

Push the needle inside the head on round 15 and through inside go from side to side of the head taking the needle out in the same round but 14 stitches away from the spot where you introduce it first. Pull the yarn a bit and repeat the procedure twice.

Sew the eye patches to the face, with their wider side towards down and matching their internal border with round 15 of the head.

Sew the nose to the tip of the muzzle. Then, with black yarn and chain stitches embroider the mouth.

On the eyeballs, with black yarn and chain stitches, embroider a round over the color exchange between black and White. Then, over the internal half of the eye's front side embroider the pupil with black color and the iris with Brown color (the iris is a chain stitch row over the external edge of the pupil). Finally, with white yarn embroider 2 light points inside the pupils. Sew the eyes to both sides of the muzzle, vertically centered over the black patches of the face.

Sew the ears to the tip of the head over round 28 and leaving 12 stitches of distance between them. Sew the body to the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back.

In order to assemble the legs to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the leg, on round 28. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side between rounds 11 & 12, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice

to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other leg.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the arm, on round 35. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 32, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

With white yarn mark the toes and fingers on as in the final Project.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body. Tie an orange ribbon piece around the bear's neck.

Baby Bear:

On the head, in order to mark the eye orbits, thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and do as following:

Push the needle inside the head between rounds 9 & 10 and through inside go from side to side of the head taking the needle out in the same round but 8 stitches away from the spot where you introduce it first. Pull the yarn a bit and repeat the procedure twice. Then, with black yarn embroider the nose and mouth. Sew the eye patches to the face matching their internal border with round 9 of the head.

With black yarn embroider the pupils over the centre of the eyes and with white yarn embroider a small mark inside the pupils. Sew the eyes to the face vertically centered over the eye patches.

Sew the ears to the tip of the head over round 16 and leaving 6 stitches of distance between them.

Sew the body to the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back.

In order to assemble the legs to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the leg, between round 15 & 16. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side between rounds 6 & 7, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other leg.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the arm, on round 18. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 18, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

With white yarn mark the toes and fingers on as in the final Project.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body.

Tie a turquoise ribbon piece around the baby bear's neck.
