

## Peppermint, The Pegasus

### Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: mint-green, brandeis-blue, sky-blue, ultramarine and white.

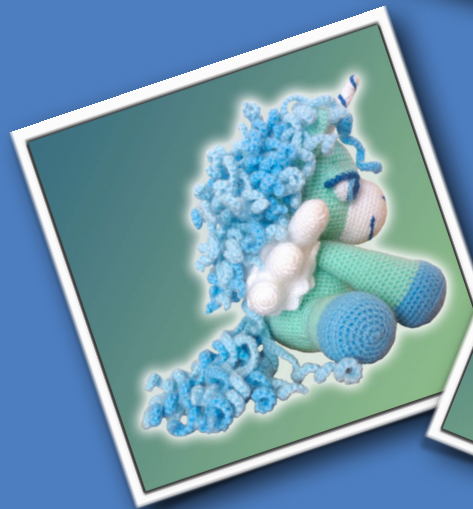
C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

### Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet and picot stitch..

### Finished Size

8.5 inches tall.

# Realization

## Head and body (mint-green color):

The head and body are crocheted in a single piece from top to bottom and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.



To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 24: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 26: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 29: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 30: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 31: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 32: Single crochet in each stitch through front loops only.

Rnd 33 & 34: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Since next round you will start crocheting the body, shaping the back's curvature:**

Rnd 35: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; 13 single crochet; \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch (30 stitches).

Rnd 36 & 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 38: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; 14 single crochet; \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch (36 stitches).

Rnd 39 & 40: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 41: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; 15 single crochet; \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch (42 stitches).

Rnd 42 & 43: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 44: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; 16 single crochet; \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch (48 stitches).

Rnd 45 & 46: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 47: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; 17 single crochet; \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch (54 stitches).

Rnd 48 & 49: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 50: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times; 18 single crochet; \*2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* twice, 2 single crochet in next stitch (60 stitches).

Rnd 51 to 56: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 57: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 58: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 59: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 60: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 61: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 62: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 63: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 64: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 65: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

### Muzzle (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

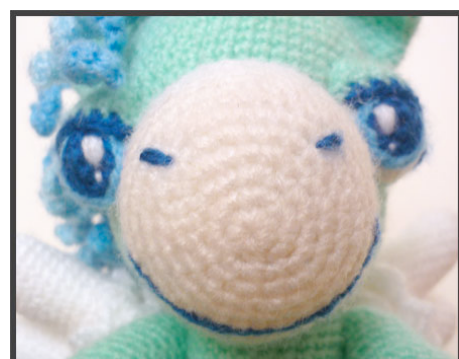
Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.



Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

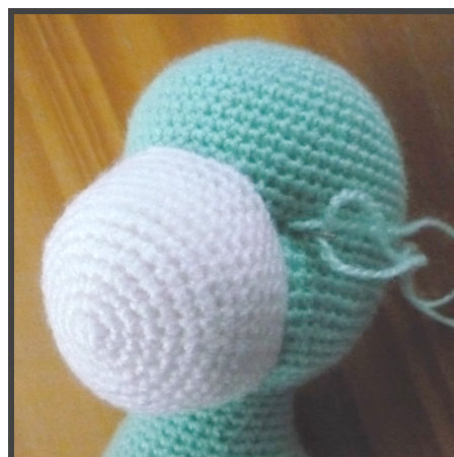
Sew the muzzle by its opening on the front side of the head, between rounds 16 and 31.

With ultramarine yarn embroider the mouth and nostrils

on the muzzle.

Thread a tapestry needle with mint-green yarn and with it mark the eye orbits like this:

Push the needle inside the head on round 20, and



through inside, go from side to side of the head, taking it out on the same round but on the opposite side of the muzzle. Pull the yarn a bit and repeat the procedure 3 times. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### **Eyes:**

Crochet all pieces twice.

### **Eyeballs:**

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

#### **White color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 1 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (14 stitches).

Rnd 4: 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet (18 stitches).

#### **Switch to mint-green color:**

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: 4 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 5 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 3 single crochet (14 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them lightly with stuffing.

### **Pupils (ultramarine color):**

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Place the pupils over the internal half of the eyeballs' front side and sew them. Then, with brandeis-blue color embroider a chain stitch round all around the pupils' borderline in order to mark the irises. With white yarn embroider 2 dots on each pupil to enlight them.

### **Eyelids (mint-green color):**

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 1 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (14 stitches).

Rnd 4: 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet (18 stitches).



Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Crochet 5 extra single crochet. Switch to **ultramarine color** and join the borderline together with a single crochet round of 9 stitches plus a picot stitch on the last single crochet (that's the tail of the eyelashes). **IMPORTANT: When you crochet the second eyelid, work the picot stitch on the first single crochet instead of on the last.**

Sew the eyeballs to the face, placing their internal angles in the eyeorbits. Then, place the eyelids a little bit over the eyeballs and with the picot stitch towards out and sew them with invisible stitches.



### Mane:

The Pegasus' mane consists in 3 rows of curls, 2 in brandeis-blue color on the sides and 1 in sky-blue color on the middle. These rows are crocheted the same way, directly on the back side of the head, from tip to neck.

#### Row of Curls:

Row 1: 30 single crochet.

Row 2: \*in the first stitch work a foundation chain of 30 stitches and 1 single crochet row on it; 2 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* 14 times; work a foundation chain of 30 stitches and 1 single crochet row on it (15 curls).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Repeat the same instructions for the other 2 rows of curls in order to complete the mane.

### Horn (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 4 single crochet (6 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 5 single crochet (7 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 6 single crochet (8 stitches).

Rnd 14 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Thread a tapestry needle with ultramarine yarn, and with it, embroider in chain stitches a spiral line over the horn, from tip to bottom.

Sew the horn centered on the forehead, placing it in front of the mane's first curls.



## Ears (mint-green color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (22 stitches).



Rnd 7: \*10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 8 & 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: \*10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 11: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (20 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the ears to the tip of the head, as you can see in the image.

## Wings (white color):

Make 2. The wings are crocheted from top to bottom, starting on the feathers and have to be filled lightly with stuffing as you go.

### Feather "A":

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### Feather "B":

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### Feather "C":

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).



Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Do not cut the yarn off. Sew the feathers together by 3 stitches, placing feathers "A" and "C" on the sides, and continue crocheting the wings around them:**



Rnd 1: 40 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (35 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7.: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 15: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 16: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

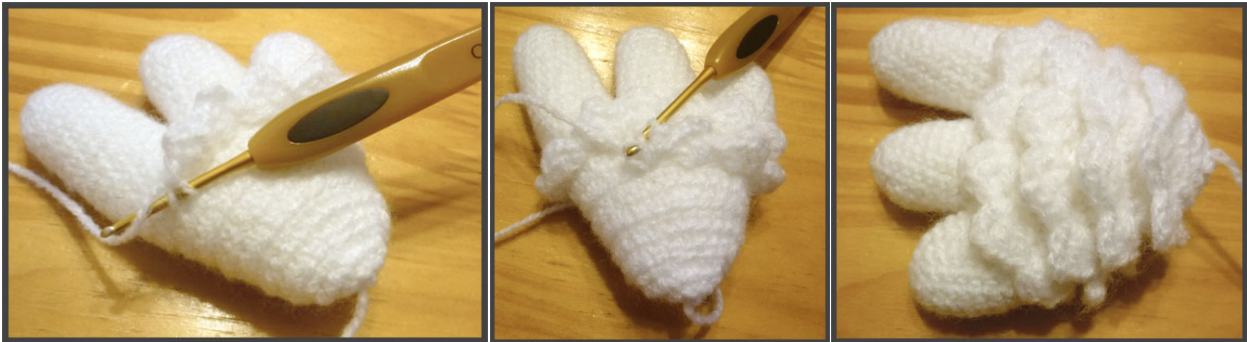
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.





## Rounds of feathers:

The 4 rounds of feathers are crocheted directly on the wings, on rounds 5, 8, 11 and 14. In order to do so, just insert your hook on the front loops of each of those four rounds



and crochet as following: \*3 chain stitches and 2 double crochet in first stitch, skip next 2 stitches, 1 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* till the end of each round, closing them with a slip stitch.

Sew the wings to the back side of the Pegasus, placing the longest feather (feather “A”) towards up.

## Forelegs (Make 2):

The forelegs are crocheted from bottom to top and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

### Brandeis-blue color:



Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

### Switch to mint-green color:

Rnd 12: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 18 to 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 22: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 23 to 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 28 to 31: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 32: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 33 & 34: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 35: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

## Hind legs (Make 2):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

### Brandeis-blue color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

### Switch to mint-green color:

Rnd 12: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 20 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them with stuffing.



Sew the hind legs to the body by their openings, placing them between rounds 44 and 55 and leaving 2.5 inches of distance between them. Then, sew the forelegs to the body, placing their top borders below round 33.

## Tail:

The tail consists in a mint-green base circle and 2 rounds of curls, 1 in brandeis-blue color and 1 in sky-blue color.

### Base (mint-green color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch through back loops only (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### First round of curls (brandeis-blue color):



This round of curls is crocheted on the first round of the base circle, through front loops only:

\*1 single crochet, 1 foundation chain of 45 stitches and 1 single crochet row on it\* repeat from \*to\* till the end of the round (6 curls).

### Second round of curls (sky-blue color):

This round of curls is crocheted on the second round of the base circle, through front loops only:

\*1 single crochet, 1 foundation chain of 45 stitches and 1 single crochet row on it\* repeat from \*to\* till the end of the round (12 curls).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body, placing it between rounds 52 and 55 and centered regarding the wings.

## Ending Details

Sew the muzzle by its opening on the front side of the head, between rounds 16 and 31.

With ultramarine yarn embroider the mouth and nostrils on the muzzle.

Thread a tapestry needle with mint-green yarn and with it mark the eye orbits like this:

Push the needle inside the head on round 20, and through inside, go from side to side of the head, taking it out on the same round but on the opposite side of the muzzle. Pull the yarn a bit and repeat the procedure 3 times. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the eyeballs to the face, placing their internal angles in the eyeorbits. Then, place the eyelids a little bit over the eyeballs and with the picot stitch towards out and sew them with invisible stitches.

Thread a tapestry needle with ultramarine yarn, and with it, embroider in chain stitches a spiral line over the horn, from tip to bottom.

Sew the horn centered on the forehead, placing it in front of the mane's first curls.

Sew the ears to the tip of the head.

Sew the wings to the back side of the Pegasus, placing the longest feather (feather "A") towards up.

Sew the hind legs to the body by their openings, placing them between rounds 44 and 55 and leaving 2.5 inches of distance between them. Then, sew the forelegs to the body, placing their top borders below round 33.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body, placing it between rounds 52 and 55 and centered regarding the wings.
