
Pierre, The Chef Pig

Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: pink, hot-pink, black and white.

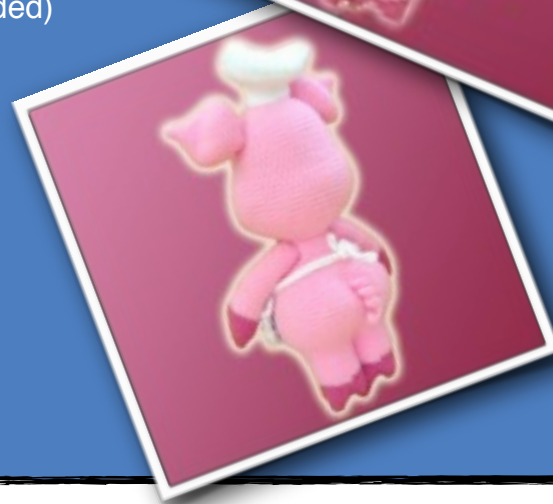
C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, sewing pins, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, half double crochet and double crochet.

Finished Size

11.5 inches tall (hat not included)



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Realization

Head (pink color):

The head is crocheted from top to bottom and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 24: *10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (72 stitches).

Rnd 25: *11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (78 stitches).

Rnd 26: *12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (84 stitches).

Rnd 27: *13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (90 stitches).

Rnd 28 to 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: *13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (84 stitches).

Rnd 32: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (78 stitches).

Rnd 33: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (72 stitches).

Rnd 34: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 35: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 36: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 37: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 38: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 39: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 40: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 41: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 42: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Body:

The body is crocheted in a single piece, from bottom to top starting on the hooves, and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Hot-pink color:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5.: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Crochet the other half of the hoof following the above instructions. Once you've finished round



6 of the second half, do not cut the yarn off. Place one half next to each other and join their borders together with 3 single crochet stitches. Then, continue crocheting around both halves:

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to pink color:

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Crochet the second leg following the above instructions.

Place one leg next to each other and sew their borders together by 6 stitches (crotch). Then, continue crocheting the body around both legs, starting the first round in the back crotch:

Rnd 1: 48 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: 3 single crochet, * 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (54 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 8 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 5: 1 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet (66 stitches).

Rnd 6: 4 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet (72 stitches).

Rnd 7: 7 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (78 stitches).

Rnd 8: *12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (84 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: 7 single crochet,* 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 12 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 decrease, 5 single crochet (78 stitches).

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: 9 single crochet,* 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 11 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 decrease, 2 single crochet (72 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: 3 single crochet,* 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 9 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (60 stitches).

Rnd 20: 4 single crochet,* 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (54 stitches).

Rnd 21: *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 22: 2 single crochet,* 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (42 stitches).

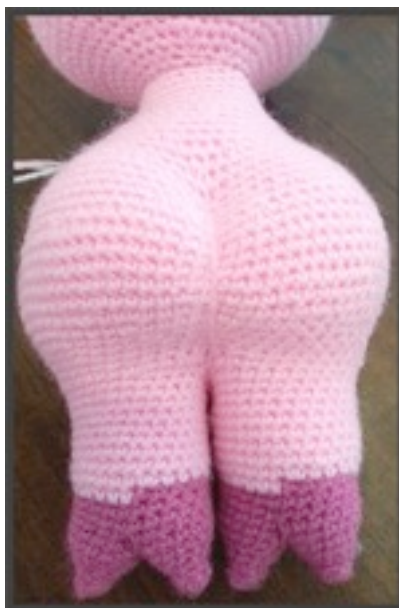
Rnd 23 & 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 26 & 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: 1 single crochet,* 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 decrease, 3 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 29 & 30: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 31: 3 single crochet,* 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 decrease (24 stitches).

Rnd 32: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the head and body together by their openings. To mark the butt crack, first thread a tapestry needle with pink yarn. Then, insert the needle between the

legs and through inside go straight up, taking the needle out on the back side of the body on round 16, pulling the yarn a bit. Repeat the procedure 2 or 3 times. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Tail (pink color):

The tail is crocheted directly on the body, above the butt crack.

Insert the hook 1 stitch above the upper ending of the butt crack and work a foundation chain of 12 stitches. Then crochet:

Row 1: 2 single crochet in each stitch (24 stitches). Join this row to the body with a slip stitch.



Row: 2 single crochet in each stitch (48 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Snout:

With **hot-pink** yarn work a foundation chain of 8 stitches, and crochet around:

Rnd 1: 7 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch (20 stitches).

Rnd 2: 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 3: 10 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 4: 11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (34 stitches).

Switch to pink color:

Rnd 5: 13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 2 single crochet (38 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the snout to the face, centered between rounds 22 & 32, filling it with stuffing as you go.

Nostrils (black color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet a single crochet round of 6 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



With black yarn thread a tapestry needle and proceed to mark the nostril areas. First insert the needle inside the head, over the top centre of its union with the snout. Through inside, go down diagonally, taking the needle out in one of the snout's foundation chain's endings. Pull the yarn a bit and secure it with a knot. Then, push the needle in the same spot you took it out and through inside return to the same place you inserted the needle at first.

Repeat the procedure a couple of times for each nostril. Once both nostrils areas are marked, sew the nostril pieces in those spots.

Eyeballs (white color):

The eyeballs are crocheted in a single piece and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Work a foundation chain of 5 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single in next stitch (14 stitches)

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 7 times, 1 single crochet (15 stitches).

Rnd 6: 7 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 7 times), 1 single crochet (8 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and make a stitch on the middle of the back side of the eyeball. Wrap the yarn twice around the eyeball in order to divide it in 2 and make another stitch in the back side in order to keep this secure.

Then, over the front side of the eyeballs and with black yarn, embroider the pupils.

Eyelids (pink color):

The eyelids are crocheted in a single piece.

Work a foundation chain of 5 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single in next stitch (14 stitches)

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each



stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Place the eyeballs inside the eyelids, with the eyelid's superior border a little bit over the pupils, and sew them together.

Sew the eyes to the face, centered over the snout.

With black yarn embroider the eyebrows and mouth, as in the final project.

Ears (pink color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 12: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Join the inferior border with a single crochet row of 12 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Fold both ends of each ear's base towards de its centre and secure them with a couple of stitches. Sew the ears to the head, between rounds 9 and 15.

Arms (Make 2):

The arms are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the hooves and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Hot-pink color:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Crochet the other half of the hoof following the above instructions.

Once you've finished round 6 of the second half, do not cut the yarn off. Place one half next to each other and join their borders together with 3 single crochet stitches. Then, continue crocheting the arm around both halves:

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to pink color:

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 16 to 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

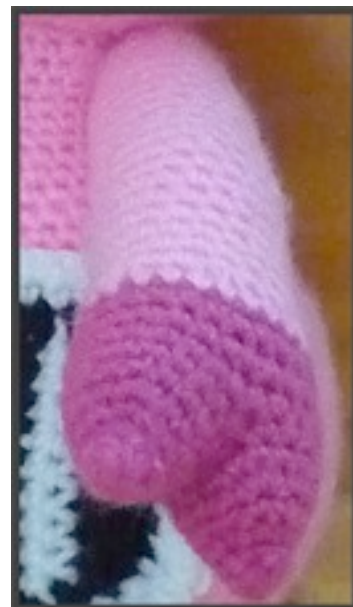
Rnd 22: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 23 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 26: 7 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 7 times) (7 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with pink yarn and make a stitch over the inner side of the arm, on round 23. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 37, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.



Chef's hat (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 15 double crochet. Close the round with a slip stitch.

Rnd 2: 2 double crochet in each stitch (30 stitches). Close the round with a slip stitch.

Rnd 3: *1 double crochet, 2 double crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 15 times (45 stitches). Close the round with a slip stitch.



Rnd 4: *2 double crochet, 2 double crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 15 times (60 stitches). Close the round with a slip stitch.

Rnd 5: Double crochet in each stitch. Close the round with a slip stitch..

Rnd 6: *2 double crochet, 1 decrease (2 double crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 15 times (45 stitches). Close the round with a slip stitch.

Rnd 7: *1 double crochet, 1 decrease (2 double crochet

closed together)*, repeat from *to* 15 times (30 stitches). Close the round with a slip stitch.

Rnd 8: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Start crocheting in a continuous spiral:

Rnd 9 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Do not fill with stuffing.

Sew the chef's hat by its opening to round 4 of the head.

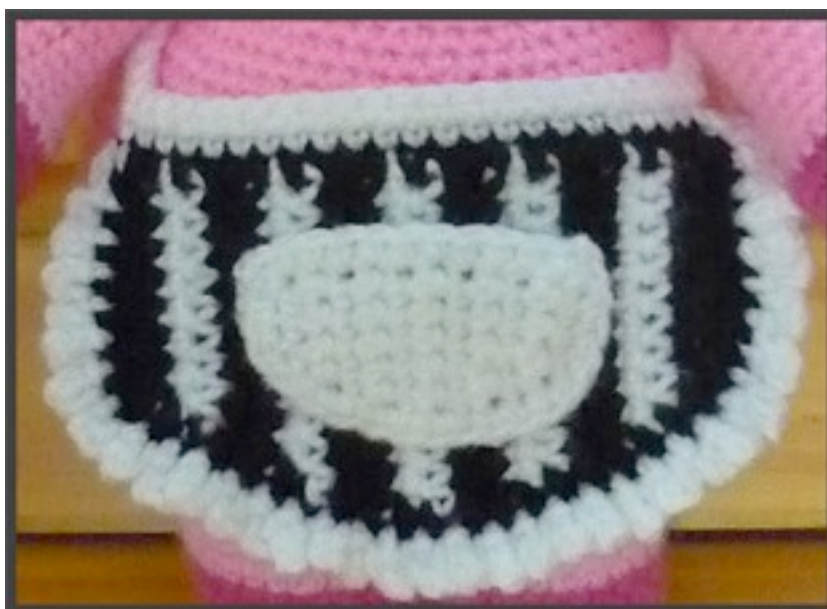
Chef's Apron:

The main piece of the chef's apron is worked in stripes, back and forth.

With **black** yarn work a foundation chain of 8 stitches:

Row 1: 8 single crochet.

Row 2: 7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch



(9 stitches)

Switch to white color:

Row 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 4: 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (10 stitches)

Switch to black color:

Row 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 6: 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (11 stitches)

Switch to white color:

Row 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 8: 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (12 stitches)

Switch to black color:

Row 9 & 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to white color:

Row 11 & 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to black color:

Row 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 14: 9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (11 stitches)

Switch to white color:

Row 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 16: 8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (10 stitches)

Switch to black color:

Row 17: Single crochet in



each stitch.

Row 18: 7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (9 stitches)

Switch to white color:

Row 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 20: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (8 stitches)

Switch to black color:

Row 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

After finishing row 21, do not cut the yarn off and crochet a single crochet round all around the chef's apron. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

With **white** color, crochet across the sides and inferior border of the chef's apron:

1 slip stitch, 4 chain stitches repeat from *to* till complete both sides and inferior border.

Waist strap (white color):

Work a foundation chain of 30 stitches. Then, without cutting the yarn off, crochet a single



crochet row of 23 stitches across the superior border of the chef's apron and then work 30 chain stitches to complete the strap (83 stitches). Turn your work around and crochet a single crochet row of 83 stitches across the entire strap.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Pocket (white color):

The pocket is worked in rows back and forth. Work and foundation chain of 4 stitches and crochet:

Row 1: 4 single crochet.

Row 2: 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (5 stitches)

Row 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 4: 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (6 stitches)

Row 5 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 8: 3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (5 stitches)

Row 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 10: 2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (4 stitches)

Row 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Without cutting the yarn off, crochet a single crochet round across all the pocket's border. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Place the pocket centered on the chef's apron, and sew it by its sides and inferior border.

Tie the chef's apron around the pig's waist.

Ending details

Sew the head and body together by their openings. To mark the butt crack, first thread a tapestry needle with pink yarn. Then, insert the needle between the legs and through inside go straight up, taking the needle out on the back side of the body in round 16, pulling the yarn a bit. Repeat the procedure 2 or 3 times.

Sew the snout to the face, centered between rounds 22 & 32, filling it with stuffing as you go.

With black yarn thread a tapestry needle and proceed to mark the nostril areas. First insert the needle inside the head, over the top centre of its union with the snout. Through inside, go down diagonally, taking the needle out in one of the snout's foundation chain's endings. Pull the yarn a bit and secure it with a knot. Then, push the needle in the same spot you took it out and through inside return to the same place you inserted the needle at first. Repeat the procedure a couple of times for each nostril. Sew the eyes to the face, centered over the snout.

With black yarn embroider the eyebrows and mouth, as in the final project.

Fold both ends of each ear's base towards de its centre and secure them with a couple of stitches. Sew the ears to the head, between rounds 9 and 15.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with pink yarn and make a stitch over the inner side of the arm, on round 23. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 37, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

Sew the chef's hat by its opening to round 4 of the head.

Place the pocket centered on the chef's apron, and sew it by its sides and inferior border.

Tie the chef's apron around the pig's waist.
