

Czornomaz, The Pirate

Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: skin, red, white, black, turquoise, brown, dark brown, grey, maize-yellow, golden-yellow, jade-green, green and blue.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, double crochet.

Finished size

12 inches tall



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Realization

Head and chest:

The head and chest are crocheted in a single piece from top to bottom.

Head (skin color):

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Skin color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

From next round you will crochet the eye orbits.

Rnd 25: 20 single crochet, *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 5 times, 20 single crochet (55 stitches).

Rnd 26: 20 single crochet, *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 5 times, 20 single crochet (50 stitches).

Rnd 27 to 40: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 41: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 42: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 43: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (35 stitches).

Rnd 44: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 45: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 46 & 47: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color. Fill the head with stuffing and continue crocheting the chest:

Chest:

Rnd 48: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 49: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 50: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to white color:

Rnd 51: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 52: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 53: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 54: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 55: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 56: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to white color:

Rnd 57: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 58: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 59: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 60 to 62: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 63: Double crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Pants (turquoise color):

The pants are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the legs.

Left leg:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Right leg:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Once you finished round 9 of the right leg, without cutting the yarn off, place both legs next to each other and join them together with 6 single crochet (crotch). Then continue crocheting the pants around the legs:

Rnd 1: 52 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 11 single crochet*, repeat from *to* 4 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Sew the pants and chest together by their openings, doing the stitches from round 62 of the chest in order to get the half double crochet round over the pants.

Eyebrows (black color):

The eyebrows are crocheted in a single



piece directly on the pirate's face or, if you prefer, could be crocheted separately and then sewn on the face. In both cases, you will have to locate this piece centered above the area where you crocheted the eye orbits, from round 24.

With black yarn, on round 24 of the head crochet:

Row 1: 18 single crochet stitches.

Row 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Beard (brown color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:



Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the beard to the face, placing it between rounds 30 and 45.

Nose (skin color):

The nose is crocheted from bottom to top and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

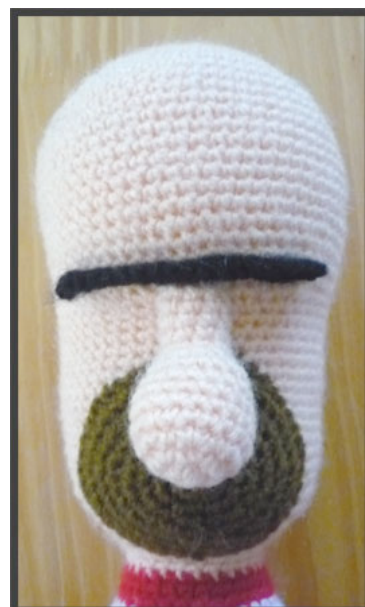
Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: 9 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 9 times) (9 stitches).

Since next round you will start crocheting the nose bridge:





Rnd 10 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.
 Sew the nose to the face, but just the bridge area, leaving the tip of the nose free. In order to do this, place the nose centered on the face, with its last round on round 24 and under the eyebrows and its tip over round 2 of the beard.

With black yarn and chain stitch, embroider the mouth across the beard, placing it horizontally across its centre. On the left side

of the mouth embroider a tooth with white yarn.

Eyes:

Crochet all pieces twice.

Eyeballs (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. DO NOT FILL THEM WITH STUFFING!

Pupils (black color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet 5 single crochet stitches. DO NOT CLOSE THE ROUND WITH A SLIP STITCH in order to get the pupils in a semicircle shape.

Sew the pupils over the front side of the eyeballs, matching their straight side with the last round of the eyeballs.

Then, with white yarn embroider a dot inside the pupils as lighting spots.

Place the eyeballs to each side of the nose bridge and under the eyebrows, matching their openings with round 24 of the face. Sew them with invisible stitches.



Ears (skin color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).



Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 7: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 8: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 6 stitches.



Earring (golden-yellow color):

The earring is crocheted directly on the left ear. In order to do so, you just have to insert your hook on the front side of the ear, between rounds 4 & 5 and crochet 10 chain stitches.

Then, join the chain stitches to the back side of the ear with a slip stitch made between rounds 4 & 5. Inside this “circle” crochet 15 single crochet stitches and join it to the ear with a slip stitch. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the ears to both sides of the head between rounds 24 and 30.

Eye patch (dark-brown color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

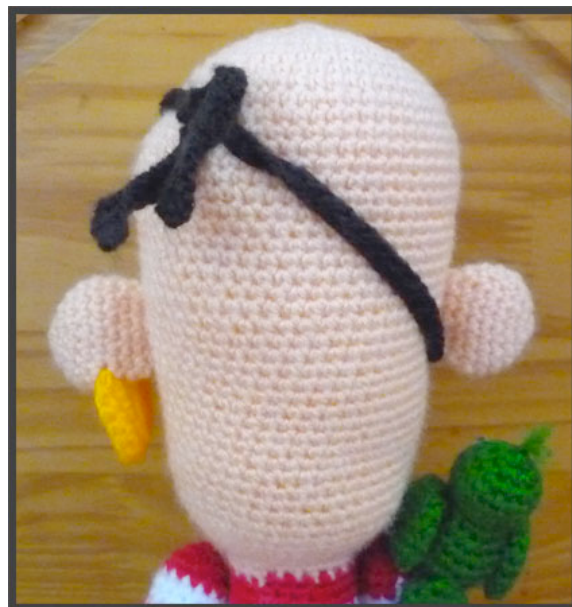


Eye patch strips:

With dark-brown yarn crochet 40 chain stitches. Then, continue crocheting over the eye patch, joining its borderline together with a single crochet row of 9 stitches. Next to this, crochet another 40 chain stitches in order to get the eye patch centered in the strip. Finally, crochet a single crochet row of 89 stitches over the chain stitches and the

eye patch. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Place the eye patch over the pirate's right eye and get and tie the strip ends on the back of the head to keep it secure.



Bandanna (jade-green color):

Work a foundation chain of 70 stitches and on them crochet:



Row 1: 70 single crochet stitches.

Row 2: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 64 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (68 stitches)

Row 3: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 62 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (66 stitches)

Row 4: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 60 single crochet, 1

decrease, 1 single crochet (64 stitches)

Row 5: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 58 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (62 stitches)

Row 6: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 56 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (60 stitches)

Row 7: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 54 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (58 stitches)

Row 8: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 52 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (56 stitches)

Row 9: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 50 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (54 stitches)

Row 10: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 48 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (52 stitches)

Row 11: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 46 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (50 stitches)

Row 12: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 44 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (48 stitches)

Row 13: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 42 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (46 stitches)

Row 14: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 40 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (44 stitches)

Row 15: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 38 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (42 stitches)

Row 16: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 36 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (40 stitches)

Row 17: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 34 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (38 stitches)

Row 18: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 32 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (36 stitches)

Row 19: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 30 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (34 stitches)

Row 20: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 28 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (32 stitches)

Row 21: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 26 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (30 stitches)

Row 22: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 24 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (28 stitches)

Row 23: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 22 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (26 stitches)

Row 24: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 20 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (24 stitches)

Row 25: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 18 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (22 stitches)

Row 26: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 16 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (20 stitches)

Row 27: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 14 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (18 stitches)

Row 28: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 12 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (16 stitches)

Row 29: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 10 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (14 stitches)

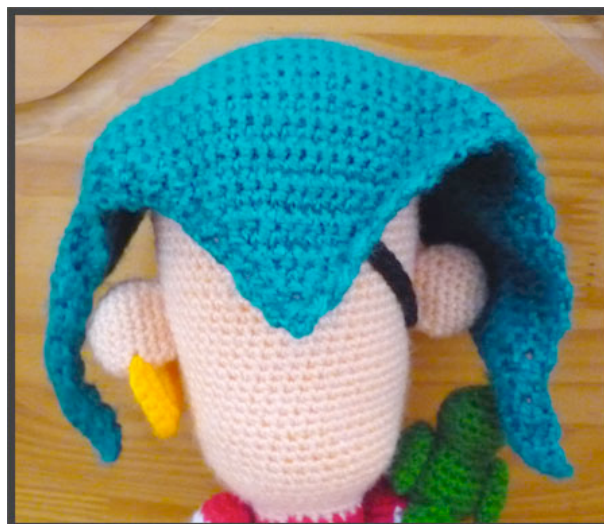
Row 30: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (12 stitches)

Row 31: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (10 stitches)

Row 32: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (8 stitches)

Row 33: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (6 stitches)

Row 34: 1 single crochet, 2 decreases (2 single crochet closed together twice), 1 single crochet (4 stitches)



Row 35: 2 decreases (2 single crochet closed together twice) (2 stitches)

Row 36: 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together) (1 stitch)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

In order to put the bandanna on the pirate's head, first place the triangle with its base on the forehead and the apex on the backside. Then, tie the base endings on the back of the head.

Boot (dark-brown color):

Work a foundation chain of 16 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet around them:

Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 14 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (36 stitches)

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (40 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (44 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: 12 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 7 times, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 9: 13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 12 & 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing till round 13.

Sew the boot to round 5 of the left leg by its opening, making the stitches from round 13 of the boot in order to get its latest 4 rounds over the leg.

Pegleg:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Brown color:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).



Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 4 to 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to grey color:

Rnd 16: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (20 stitches)

Rnd 17 to 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (24 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Sew the pegleg by its opening to round 5 of the right leg. With grey yarn embroider a chain stitch round over the union between the pegleg and the right leg.

Belt (brown color):

Work a foundation chain of 50 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around them crochet:



Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 48 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 48 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (104 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Belt clasp (Maize-yellow color):

Work a foundation chain of 8 stitches, close them into a circle with a slip stitch. In this circle crochet a single crochet round of 16 stitches.

Place the belt around the waist with its endings on the front side of the body and above the double crochet round of the

sweater, and sew it all around. Place the belt clasp over the belt's endings and sew it.

Arms:

Make 2. The arms are crocheted from bottom to top and have to be filled with stuffing as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Skin color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.



Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 9 single crochet, 5 double crochet closed together in next stitch, 8 single crochet (18 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9.: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Since next round you will start crocheting the sleeves.

Switch to red color (*):

Rnd 10 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to white color:

Rnd 13 to 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 16 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to white color:

Rnd 19: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 20 & 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 22 to 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to white color:

Rnd 25 to 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 28: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 29: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 30: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

(*) Before start crocheting the second arm, once you finished round 9, crochet 6 extra single crochet stitches in skin color before switching to red color in order to get all the color exchanges over the internal zone of the arm.

With red yarn and a tapestry needle embroider a chain stitch round over the color exchange between red and skin (between rounds 9 & 10).

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with red yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the arm, on round 27. Then, pass the needle through the chest from side to side on round 52, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the chest (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

Parrot:**Body (green color):**

The body is crocheted from top to bottom and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 7: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 8: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 9: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).



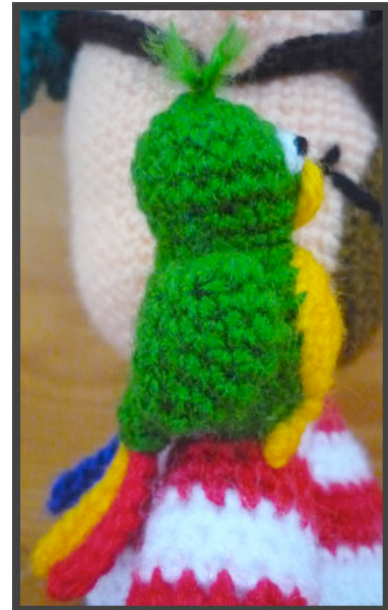
Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 16: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Over the front side of the head, embroider the eyes and beak, as you can see in the image. Add some green yarn on the top of the head as hair.



Wings (green color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Do not fill them with stuffing. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the wings to both sides of the body, diagonally.

Tail:

The tail consists in 4 pieces: base and 3 feathers.

Base (green color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

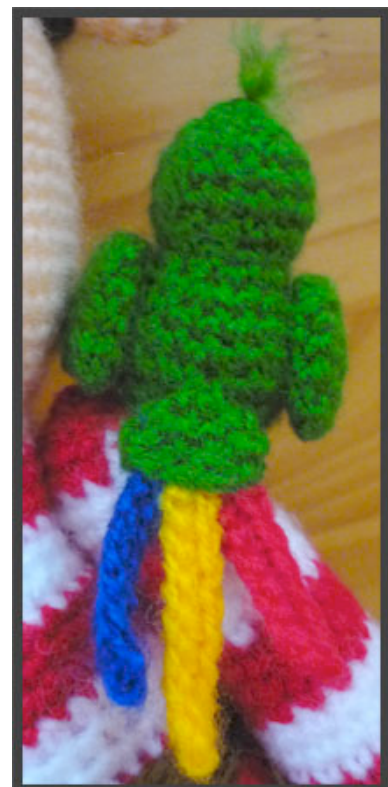
Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Feathers:

Crochet 3 feathers: 1 golden-yellow, 1 red and 1 blue as following:





Work a foundation chain of 7 stitches and on them crochet a single crochet row. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Place 1 ending of each feather inside the tail's base and sew them.

Sew the tail to the back side of the parrot's body.

Chest (golden-yellow color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the chest to the front side of the parrot's body.

Sew the parrot to the right arm of the pirate. Once it's sewn on, with golden-yellow yarn embroider the parrot's toes on the pirate arm.

Ending details

Pirate:

Sew the pants and chest together by their openings, doing the stitches from round 62 of the chest in order to get the half double crochet round over the pants.

Sew the beard to the face, placing it between rounds 30 and 45.

Sew the nose to the face, but just the bridge area, leaving the tip of the nose free. In order to do this, place the nose centered on the face, with its last round on round 24 and under the eyebrows and its tip over round 2 of the beard.

With black yarn and chain stitch, embroider the mouth across the beard, placing it horizontally across its centre. On the left side of the mouth embroider a tooth with white yarn.

Sew the pupils over the front side of the eyeballs, matching their straight side with the last round of the eyeballs. Then, with white yarn embroider a dot inside the pupils as lighting spots.

Place the eyeballs to each side of the nose bridge and under the eyebrows, matching their openings with round 24 of the face. Sew them with invisible stitches.

Sew the ears to both sides of the head between rounds 24 and 30.

Place the eye patch over the pirate's right eye and get and tie the strip ends on the back of the head to keep it secure.

In order to put the bandanna on the pirate's head, first place the triangle with its base on the forehead and the apex on the backside. Then, tie the base endings on the back of the head.

Sew the boot to round 5 of the left leg by its opening, making the stitches from round 13 of the boot in order to get its latest 4 rounds over the leg.

Sew the pegleg by its opening to round 5 of the right leg. With grey yarn embroider a chain stitch round over the union between the pegleg and the right leg.

Place the belt around the waist with its endings on the front side of the body and above the double crochet round of the sweater, and sew it all around. Place the belt clasp over the belt's endings and sew it.

In order to assemble the arms to the body, first thread a tapestry needle with red yarn and make a stitch in the inner side of the arm, on round 27. Then, pass the needle through the chest from side to side on round 52, pulling it tight in order to get the arm jointed to the chest (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other arm.

Parrot:

Over the front side of the head, embroider the eyes and beak.

Add some green yarn on the top of the head as hair.

Sew the wings to both sides of the body, diagonally.

Sew the tail to the back side of the parrot's body.

Sew the chest to the front side of the parrot's body.

Sew the parrot to the right arm of the pirate. Once it's sewn on, with golden-yellow yarn embroider the parrot's toes on the pirate arm.
