
Frosty, The Snowman

Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: white, black, blue, red, green, dark-brown, brown and orange.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet, back post double crochet, front post double crochet.

Finished Size

7 inches tall

Realization

Body (white color):

The body is crocheted in a single piece, from top to bottom, starting on the head and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 26: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).



Rnd 27: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 28: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 29: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 32: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 33: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 34: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 35: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 36: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 38: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 39: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 40: *10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (72 stitches).

Rnd 41 to 50: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 51: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 52: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 53: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 54: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 55: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 56: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 57: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 58: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 59: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 60: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 61: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 62: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 63: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Eyes (black color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Carrot nose (orange color):



Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8 : *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in

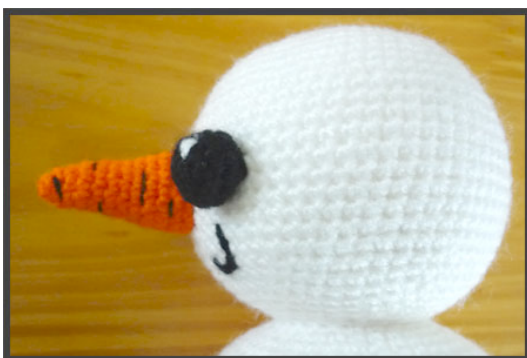
next

stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing. With dark brown yarn (or dark brown embroidery thread) embroider some horizontal lines of different length all over the nose surface to represent the carrot skin.

Sew the carrot nose to the head by its opening, placing it between rounds 15 and 21.



Sew the eyes to both sides of the carrot nose, leaving a 2 stitches of distance between each eye and the nose. With white yarn embroider a small dot on each eye as lighting points.

With black yarn and chain stitches embroider the mouth in a small “U”shape, placing it slightly inclined over one side.

Arms (brown color):

The arms are 2 tree branches crocheted from bottom to top, starting on 2 little pieces joined together.

Piece 1:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Piece 2:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Once you've finished crocheting round 3 of Piece 2, do not cut the yarn off. Place both pieces next to each other and sew their borderline together by 2 stitches. Then continue crocheting the arm all around:

Rnd 1: 10 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them with stuffing. With dark brown yarn (or dark brown embroidery thread) embroider some vertical lines of different lengths all over the arms surface to represent the branch bark.

Sew the arms by their openings to both sides of the body, placing them between rounds 35 and 40.



Sneakers:

Make 2. The sneakers are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the outer sole and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Green color:

Work a foundation chain of 16 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and continue crocheting around them:



Rnd 1: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 14 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (36 stitches)

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* twice (40 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (44 stitches).

Switch to blue color:

Rnd 4 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: 12 single crochet, * 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet * repeat from *to* 7 times, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 9: 13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 10: 11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 7 single crochet (26 stitches).

Rnd 11: 2 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 10 single crochet*, repeat from *to* twice (24 stitches)

Rnd 12: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 13: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 14: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

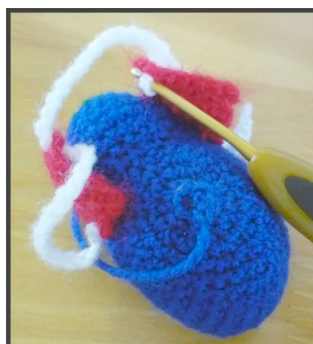
Lace Guards (red color):

Make 4 (2 per sneaker).

Work a foundation chain of 6 stitches and on them crochet 3 single crochet rows. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sneaker Laces (white color):

Make 2. Work a foundation chain of 50 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



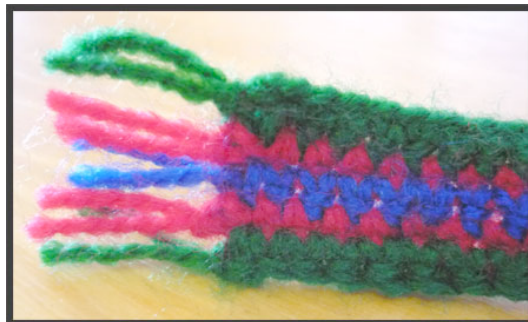
Sew the laces guards over the top-front of the sneakers and then, tie them together with the laces, making a bow with their endings, as you can see in the images.

Sew the sneakers underneath the body.

Scarf:

With green yarn work a foundation chain of 100 stitches, and on them crochet 5 single crochet rows, with the colors interspersed as follows: green, red, blue, red, green. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Add some pieces of fringe of different colors to both ends of the scarf.

Wrap the scarf around the neck twice, pulling it a little bit. Make a knot with the scarf endings on the front side of the body.



Hat:

The hat is crocheted back and forth, not in spiral, closing each round with a slip stitch and turning around your work after finishing each round in order to start the next one.

With green yarn work a foundation chain of 55 stitches and close them into a circle with a slip stitch. Over them crochet a double crochet round. Then crochet 5 rounds interspersing 1 back post double crochet and 1 front post double crochet in order to get an elastic fabric.



Once you've done with the elastic part of the hat, crochet 37 single crochet rounds, interspersing 1 round of each color (green, red and blue). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Hat Strap:

With blue yarn work a foundation chain of 60 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Wrap the strap around the hat, 5 rounds before its ending and tie it with a bow, as you can see in the image.

Put the hat on the snowman's head.

Ending Details

Sew the carrot nose to the head by its opening, placing it between rounds 15 and 21.

Sew the eyes to both sides of the carrot nose, leaving a 2 stitches of distance between each eye and the nose. With white yarn embroider a small dot on each eye as lighting points.

With black yarn and chain stitch embroider the mouth in a small "U" shape, placing it slightly inclined over one side.

Sew the arms by their openings to both sides of the body, placing them between rounds 35 and 40.

Sew the sneakers underneath the body.

Wrap the scarf around the neck twice, pulling it a little bit. Make a knot with the scarf endings on the front side of the body.

Put the hat on the snowman's head.
