

Spaceship and Astronaut

Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: light-grey, dark-grey, red, white, sky-blue, yellow, orange, ivory, skin, blue, terracota and black.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, single crochet, back post single crochet and picot stitch..

Finished Size

Spaceship: 10.6 inches tall

Astronaut: 4.3 inches tall



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Realization

Spaceship:

Nose cone (Red color):

The nose cone consists in 2 pieces: inferior and superior.

Nose cone - Inferior piece:

To avoid a hole at the beginning of this piece, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (48 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Nose cone - Superior Piece:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: 1 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).



Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (48 stitches).

Rnd 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Join both pieces together, inferior and superior, by their borders with 2 single crochet rounds, filling with stuffing as you go and following these instructions:

Rnd 1: 3 single crochet, * 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (54 stitches).

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Body Tube - Exhaust Nozzle (Dark-grey color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet through back loops only:



Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: 3 single crochet, * 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: Back post single crochet in each stitch.

Continue crocheting in regular single crochet:

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 13: Back post single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 16: Back post single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Body Tube - Exhaust Nozzle top circle (Dark-grey color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Without cutting the yarn off, place the top circle over the exhaust nozzle's opening. With the top circle facing you, join the borderlines together with a single crochet round of 42 stitches, filling with stuffing as you go.

Turn your work around in order to get the right side towards out and continue crocheting the body tube.

Body tube - External piece:

Rnd 1: Through **FRONT** loops only crochet *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 2: 3 single crochet, * 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (54 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 8 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch through **BACK** loops only.

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to light-grey color:

Rnd 6: 1 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet (66 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: 4 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet (72 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: 7 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (78 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (84 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (78 stitches).

Rnd 32 & 33: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 34: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (72 stitches).

Rnd 35 & 36: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 37: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 38 & 39: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 40: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 41 & 42: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 43: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 44 & 45: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 46: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Body tube - Internal piece (Dark-grey color):

The first round of the internal piece of the body



tube is crocheted directly on the back loops from round 1 of the external piece. In order to accomplish this, first turn the external piece of the body tube inside out and then, insert your crochet hook in each loose loop from round 1 and crochet:

Rnd 1: 42 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 3 to 38: Single crochet in each stitch.



Without cutting the yarn off, rearrange both pieces of the rocket's body tube in order to get them in their right position, then add stuffing between them, without overstuffing. Join the borderline of both pieces together with a single crochet round of 48 stitches, adding more stuffing if necessary. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the borderline of the nose cone to the body tube's opening by 14 stitches only, leaving the remaining 34 stitches loose.



Exhaust Nozzle's fire:

The fire from the exhaust nozzle is crocheted in spiral, across the front loops of its base circle, from centre towards out. You need to crochet the first 4 rounds in **yellow**, then 2 **orange** rounds and end with 2 rounds in **red**, as following:

2 single crochet, 1 picot stitch repeat from *to* until covering the whole surface from the base circle.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Side-rockets (Make 3):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Red color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: 1 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to dark-grey color:

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch through **BACK** loops only.

Switch to light-grey color:

Rnd 9: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Switch to dark-grey color:

Rnd 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch through **BACK** loops only.

Rnd 23: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 24: Single crochet in each stitch through **FRONT** loops only.

Rnd 25: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 26: 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 4 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (30 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.



Side-rockets - Inferior circle (Dark-grey color):

Make 3. Into a double adjustable ring crochet through **BACK** loops only:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Place the inferior circle over the rocket's opening and join their borderline together with a single crochet round of 30 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Side-rockets - Exhaust Nozzle's fire:

The fire from the side-rockets' exhaust nozzles is crocheted in spiral, across the front loops of their base circle, from centre towards out. You need to crochet the first 2 rounds in **yellow**, then 1 **orange** round and the last round in **red**, as following:

2 single crochet, 1 picot stitch repeat from *to* until covering the whole surface from the base circle. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Assemble piece of the side-rockets (Dark-grey color):

Make 3. Work a foundation chain of 7 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and around it crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet (15 stitches).

Rnd 2: 7 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet (17 stitches).

Rnd 3: 8 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet (19 stitches).

Rnd 4: 9 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet (21 stitches).

Rnd 5: 10 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet (23 stitches).

Rnd 6: 11 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet (25 stitches).

Rnd 7: 12 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 12 single crochet (27 stitches).

Rnd 8: 13 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 13 single crochet (29 stitches).

Rnd 9: 14 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet (31 stitches).

Rnd 10: 15 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 15 single crochet (33 stitches).

Without cutting the yarn off, fill with stuffing and then, join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 16 stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the narrowed ending of the assemble pieces to each side-rockets' body tubes. Then, sew the wider ending of the assemble pieces to the body tube of the spaceship, placing them between rounds 5 and 25 and leaving 19 stitches of distance between them (count those 19 stitches over round 5 of the spaceship's body-tube).

Windows (Make 6):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

White color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: In **white** color crochet *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times; switch to **sky-blue** color and crochet *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (30 stitches).

Switch to dark-grey color:

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: Back post single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the windows to the spaceship's body-tube, grouping them in pairs and placing each group centered between 2 side-rockets and with their sky-blue areas towards down. Place the inferior windows between rounds 10 and 26 and the superior windows between rounds 28 and 44.



Astronaut:

Head (skin color):

The head is crocheted from tip to bottom and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:



Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 15: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 16: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Helmet (Ivory color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to blue color:

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Place the head inside the helmet and sew it all around, making the stitches from round 12 of the helmet in order to get the blue borderline



loose.

With terracota color and long stitches, embroider the astronaut's hair. With black yarn, embroider the face features: 2 french knots as eyes and a chain stitch line in "U" shape as mouth.

Headphones (Blue color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.



Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing. Sew the headphones to both sides of the helmet, halfway up.

Antenna (Dark-grey color):

The antenna consists in a foundation chain of 5 stitches:

Insert your hook in the tip of the left headphone and work 5 chain stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Body (Ivory color):



The body is crocheted from bottom to top and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since next round you're going to start shaping the back's curvature:

Rnd 8: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (22 stitches).

Rnd 9: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice, 6 single crochet (20 stitches).

Rnd 10: 6 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single

crochet closed together), 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (17 stitches).

Rnd 11: 7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet (16 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the body to the helmet by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back side.

Legs (Make 2):

Make 2. The legs are crocheted from bottom to top and have to be stuffed as you go.

Blue color:

Work a foundation chain of 6 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet around:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (14 stitches).

Switch to ivory color:

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: 5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (12 stitches).

Rnd 5: 5 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet (10 stitches).

Rnd 6 & 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to blue color:

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to ivory color:

Rnd 9 & 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



Arms (ivory color):



Make 2. The arms are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the hands, and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 5 single crochet, 3 double crochet closed together in next stitch, 4 single crochet (10 stitches).

Rnd 6 & 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to blue color:

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to ivory color:

Rnd 9 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

In order to assemble the astronaut's limbs, first thread a tapestry needle with ivory yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of 1 leg, between rounds 9 and 10. Then, pass the

needle through the body from side to side between rounds 6 and 7, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other leg and then, for the arms, but in this case insert the needle between rounds 12 and 14 of the body.

Backpack (Dark-grey color):

Work a foundation chain of 6 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet around:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (14 stitches).

Rnd 2 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Fill with stuffing and join the borderline together with a single crochet row of 6 stitches.



Straps (Make 2):

The backpack's straps consist in 2 strings of 10 chain stitches each:

Insert your hook in one of the backpack's corner.

Work 10 chain stitches and then, insert your

hook in the superior corner and work 1 slip stitch. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Repeat the same instructions for the other strap.

Place the backpack on the astronaut's back and secure it with the straps, passing them through his arms.

Ending Details

Spaceship:

Sew the borderline of the nose cone to the body tube's opening by 14 stitches only, leaving the remaining 34 stitches loose.

Sew the narrowed ending of the assemble pieces to each side-rockets' body tubes. Then, sew the wider ending of the assemble pieces to the body tube of the spaceship, placing them between rounds 5 and 25 and leaving 19 stitches of distance between them (count those 19 stitches over round 5 of the body-tube of the spaceship).

Sew the windows to the spaceship's body-tube, grouping them in pairs and placing each group centered between 2 side-rockets and with their sky-blue areas towards down. Place the inferior windows between rounds 10 and 26 and the superior windows between rounds 28 and 44.

Astronaut:

Place the head inside the helmet and sew it all around, making the stitches from round 12 of the helmet in order to get the blue borderline loose.

With terracotta color and long stitches, embroider the astronaut's hair. With black yarn, embroider the face features: 2 french knots as eyes and a chain stitch line in "U" shape as mouth.

Sew the headphones to both sides of the helmet, halfway up.

Sew the body to the helmet by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back side.



In order to assemble the astronaut's limbs, first thread a tapestry needle with ivory yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of 1 leg, between rounds 9 and 10. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side between rounds 6 and 7, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other leg and then, for the arms, but in this case insert the needle between rounds 12 and 14 of the body.

Place the backpack on the astronaut's back and secure it with the straps, passing them through his arms.

Place the astronaut inside the spaceship and in 5..4..3..2..1....Launch to Space!!!!
