## Baby Giraffe

### *Materials:*

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: mustard, terracotta, black, white, sky blue, brown and beige.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing, scissors, black sewing thread and orange ribbon.

### *Stitches used in the Project:*

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, single crochet through back loops only and half double crochet.

### *Finished size:*

**Giraffe:** 27 cm/ 10.6 inches tall

**Teddy Bear:** 9.5 cm/ 3.74 inches tall (standing position)

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# Realization



## *Giraffe:*

### *Body:*

The body is crocheted in a single piece, starting on the horns and has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

### **Terracotta color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

### **Switch to mustard color:**

Rnd 5: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing. Work the other horn following the upper instructions, but once you finish round 10, do not cut the yarn off. Join both horns by sewing their borders together in 2 stitches. Then continue crocheting the head around both horns:**

Rnd 1: 12 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 9: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).  
Rnd 10 to 15: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 16: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).  
Rnd 17: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 18: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).  
Rnd 19: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 20: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).  
Rnd 21: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).  
Rnd 22: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).  
Rnd 23: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (15 stitches).  
Rnd 24 to 29: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 30: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (16 stitches)  
Rnd 31 & 32: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 33: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (17 stitches)  
Rnd 34 & 35: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 36: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (18 stitches)  
Rnd 37 & 38: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 39: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (19 stitches)  
Rnd 40 & 41: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 42: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (20 stitches)  
Rnd 43 & 44: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 45: \*9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (22 stitches).  
Rnd 46: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 47: \*10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (24 stitches).  
Rnd 48: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 49: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).  
Rnd 50: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).  
Rnd 51: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).  
Rnd 52 to 57: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 58: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).  
Rnd 59: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).  
Rnd 60: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (60 stitches).  
Rnd 61 to 68: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 69: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).  
Rnd 70: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 71: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 72: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 73: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).  
Rnd 74: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Rnd 75: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).  
Rnd 76: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).  
Rnd 77: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).  
Rnd 78: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).  
Rnd 79: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).  
Rnd 80: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).  
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

### *Muzzle (terracotta color):*

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 13: \*10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 14: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet (22 stitches)

Rnd 17: 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet (24 stitches)

Rnd 18: Single crochet in next stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.



Sew the muzzle to the face by its opening, centered regarding the horns and with its superior border under round 13th of the head.

### **Eyes:**

#### **Big Eyeball (white color):**

The eyeball has to be filled with stuffing while you're crocheting it. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 7: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 8: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

#### **Small Eyeball (White color):**

The eyeball has to be filled with stuffing while you're crocheting it. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 6: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 7: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

#### **Big Pupil (black color):**

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: \*2 single crochet in each stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice, \*2 half double crochet in each stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice, \*2 single crochet in each stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

#### **Small Pupil (black color):**

Into a double adjustable ring work: 2 single crochet, 3 half double crochet, 2 single crochet (7 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

#### **Eyelid (terracotta color):**

Work a foundation chain of 23 stitches. On it crochet 3 single crochet rows. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



**Eyes' assemble:** Sew the eyeballs on the giraffe's face with their centers over the muzzle's superior border and placing the big one on the right and the small one on the left.

Sew the pupils on the front side of the eyeballs and then, with white yarn embroider 2 points of light on each pupil.

Place the eyelid around the sides and tops of the eyeballs and sew it.



### *Ears (mustard color):*

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (16 stitches).

Rnd 6 & 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (8 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the ears to the head, 5 rounds below the horns base.



### *Pacifier (sky blue color):*

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches)

Rnd 5: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).  
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fill with stuffing the tip of the piece (3 first rounds).

**Pacifier handle (sky blue color):**

The pacifier handle is crocheted directly on the pacifier. In order to do this, just insert your hook in 1 stitch of the 3rd round of the pacifier, work 10 chain stitches and insert the hook again on the 3rd round of the pacifier, 2 stitches away from the other stitch and crochet 1 slip stitch. Then crochet 16 single crochet stitches into the chain stitches circle. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the pacifier to the tip of the muzzle. Then, with black yarn embroider the nostrils on the muzzle, 3 rounds above the pacifier.



**Back legs:**

Make 2. The back legs are crocheted from bottom to top and you need to stuff them as you go. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

**Terracotta color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 6: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (22 stitches)

Rnd 7: 5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 5 single crochet (20 stitches)

Rnd 8: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (18 stitches)

Rnd 9: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times, 3 single crochet (15 stitches)

Rnd 10: 2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 2 single crochet (11 stitches)

**Switch to mustard color:**

Rnd 11 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches)

Rnd 24: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (16 stitches).

Rnd 25: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 26: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (20 stitches).  
 Rnd 27: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 28: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (24 stitches).  
 Rnd 29: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 30: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).  
 Rnd 31 to 38: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 39: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).  
 Rnd 40 to 42: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 43: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).  
 Rnd 44: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 45: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).  
 Rnd 46: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).  
 Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.  
 Sew the back legs to both sides of the body under round 58 of it.

### *Forelegs:*

Make 2. The forelegs are crocheted from bottom to top and you have to stuff them as you go.  
 Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

#### **Terracotta color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.  
 Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).  
 Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).  
 Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).  
 Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.  
 Rnd 6: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (22 stitches)  
 Rnd 7: 5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 5 single crochet (20 stitches)  
 Rnd 8: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (18 stitches)  
 Rnd 9: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times, 3 single crochet (15 stitches)  
 Rnd 10: 2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 2 single crochet (11 stitches)

#### **Switch to mustard color:**

Rnd 11 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 23: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches)  
 Rnd 24: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (14 stitches).  
 Rnd 25: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 26: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (16 stitches).  
 Rnd 27: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 28: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (18 stitches).  
 Rnd 29: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 30: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 31 to 39: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 40: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\* repeat from \*to\* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 42: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\* repeat from \*to\* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 43: Single crochet in each stitch

Rnd 44: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\* repeat from \*to\* 4 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 45: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the body 3 rounds above the back legs. Thread a tapestry needle with terracotta yarn (put yarn double) and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to top in order to mark the hooves as in the final project.



### *Tail (mustard color):*

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches)

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches)

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches)

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches)  
 Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 11: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10 stitches)  
 Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 13: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (11 stitches)  
 Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Rnd 15: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches)  
 Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.  
 Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it lightly. Cut some terracotta a mustard yarn pieces and fix them as hair on the tail's tip. Sew the tail by its opening to the giraffe's back side of the body.



### *Diaper (White color):*

Work a foundation chain of 55 stitches and on them crochet:

Row 1: 55 single crochet stitches.

Row 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 3: 12 slip stitch, 31 single crochet (43 stitches). Leave without crocheting the latest 12 stitches.

Row 4: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 25 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (29 stitches).

Row 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 6: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 23 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (27 stitches).

Row 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 8: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 21 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (25 stitches).

Row 9: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 10: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 19 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (23 stitches).  
Row 11: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 12: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 17 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (21 stitches).  
Row 13: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 14: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 15 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (19 stitches).  
Row 15: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 16: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 13 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (17 stitches).  
Row 17 to 27: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 28: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (19 stitches)  
Row 29: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 30: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (21 stitches)  
Row 31: Single crochet in each stitch.  
**In next row you'll crochet the diaper eyelet for the tail:**  
Row 32: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 5 chains, skip the next 5 stitches, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (23 stitches).  
Row 33: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 34: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 19 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (25 stitches)  
Row 35: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 36: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 21 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (27 stitches)  
Row 37: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 38: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 23 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (29 stitches)  
Row 39: Single crochet in each stitch.  
Row 40: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 25 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (31 stitches). Crochet 12 chain stitches.  
Row 41: 43 single crochet, 12 chain stitches.  
Row 42: 55 single crochet stitches.  
Row 43: 12 slip stitch, 43 single crochet.  
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.  
Wrap the diaper around the body, tying it on the hips. Pass the tail through the diaper eyelet.



*Teddy Bear:*



*Head (brown color):*

The head is crocheted from front to back, starting on the muzzle and it has to be stuffed as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 5 single crochet (14 stitches)

Rnd 6: 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next



stitch, 5 single crochet (16 stitches)

Rnd 7: 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet (20 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 13: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 14: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



With black yarn and embroider 2 french knots above the muzzle's curve as eyes. Then, with beige yarn embroider the nose and eyebrows as in the final project.

### **Body (Brown color):**

The body is crocheted from bottom to top and has to be stuffed as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

### **Since next round you're going to start shaping the back's curvature:**

Rnd 8: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (22 stitches).

Rnd 9: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (20 stitches).

Rnd 10: 6 single crochet, \*1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet\* repeat from \*to\* twice, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (17 stitches).

Rnd 11: 7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet (16 stitches).

Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\* repeat from \*to\* 4 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 14: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\* repeat from \*to\* 4 times (8 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Sew the body to the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back side.

### *Belly (beige color):*

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches)

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Sew the belly on the front side of the body.



### **Arms (Brown color):**

Make 2. The arms are crocheted from bottom to top and have to be stuffed as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet (9 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: 4 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 4 times), 1 single crochet (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

### **Legs:**

Make 2. The legs are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the foot soles and have to be stuffed as you go.

#### **Beige color:**

Work a foundation chain of 6 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet around them:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (14 stitches)

#### **Switch to Brown color:**

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: 5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (12 stitches).

Rnd 5: 5 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet (10 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

**Limbs assemble:** To assemble the teddy's limbs, first thread a tapestry needle with Brown yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of 1 back leg. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 4, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the

union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other back leg and then, for the forelegs, but in this case insert the needle on round 11 of the body.

With black sewing thread mark the toes on each leg as in the final Project.



### *Ears (Brown color):*

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 4 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (8 stitches)

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the ears to the tip of the teddy's head.



### *Tail (Brown color):*

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 4 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (6 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the tail to the back side of the body.

## Ending details

### *Giraffe:*

Sew the muzzle to the face by its opening, centered regarding the horns and with its superior border under round 13th of the head.

Sew the eyeballs on the giraffe's face with their centers over the muzzle's superior border and placing the big one on the right and the small one on the left.

Sew the pupils on the front side of the eyeballs and then, with white yarn embroider 2 points of light on each pupil.

Place the eyelid around the sides and tops of the eyeballs and sew it.

Sew the ears to the head, 5 rounds below the horns base.

Sew the pacifier to the tip of the muzzle. Then, with black yarn embroider the nostrils on the muzzle, 3 rounds above the pacifier.

Sew the back legs to both sides of the body under round 58 of it.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the body 3 rounds above the back legs. Thread a tapestry needle with terracotta yarn (put yarn double) and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top in order to mark the hooves as in the final project.



Cut some terracotta and mustard yarn pieces and fix them as hair, vertically across the back side of the head and neck, starting between the horns.

Sew the tail by its opening to the giraffe's back side of the body.

Thread a tapestry needle with terracotta yarn and embroider some spots over the back side of the



head, body, neck, tail and the top of the legs.

Wrap the diaper around the body, tying it on the hips. Pass the tail through the diaper eyelet.

### *Teddy Bear:*

With black yarn and embroider 2 french knots above the muzzle's curve as eyes. Then, with beige yarn embroider the nose and eyebrows as in the final project.

Sew the body to the head by its opening, placing the back's curvature to the back side.

Sew the belly on the front side of the body.

To assemble the teddy's limbs, first thread a tapestry needle with Brown yarn and make a stitch on the inner side of 1 back leg. Then, pass the needle through the body from side to side on round 4, pulling it tight in order to get the leg jointed to the body (do it twice to keep the union firm). Repeat this procedure for the other back leg and then, for the forelegs, but in this case insert the needle on round 11 of the body.

With black sewing thread mark the toes on each leg as in the final Project.

Sew the ears to the tip of the teddy's head.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body.

Wrap a piece of orange ribbon around the teddy's neck and make a bow on the front.
