## Sir Charles Caterpillar

### *Materials:*

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: forest-green, dark-green, olive-green, black, white, red, turquoise and brown.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

### *Stitches used in the Project:*

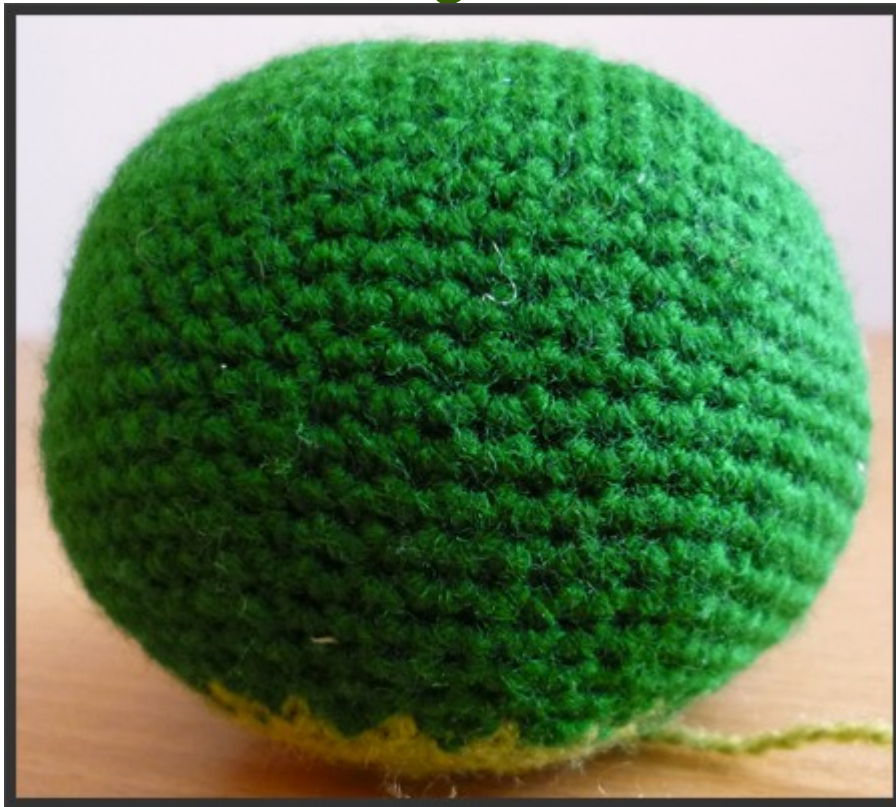
Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, single crochet, single crochet through back loops only and single crochet through front loops only.

### *Finished size:*

Height: 17 cm (6.7 inches); Length: 20 cm (7.9 inches)

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# Realization



## *Head:*

The head is crocheted from top to bottom and you have to fill this piece with stuffing while you're crocheting it.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

### **Forest-green color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 22: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 23: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 24: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

**Rnd 25: Single crochet in each stitch interspersing 1 forest-green stitch and 1 olive-green stitch.**

**Continue crocheting all stitches in olive-green color:**

Rnd 26: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 27: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 28: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 29: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 30: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



### **Body:**

The body is crocheted from front to back and has to be filled with stuffing while you're crocheting it.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

#### **Forest-green color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch interspersing 1 forest-green stitch and 1 olive-green stitch.**

**Continue crocheting all stitches in olive-green color:**

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 16: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 17: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 18: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

**Switch to forest-green color:**

Rnd 19: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 20: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 21: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 22 to 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Rnd 28: Single crochet in each stitch interspersing 1 forest-green stitch and 1 olive-green stitch.**

**Continue crocheting all stitches in olive-green color:**

Rnd 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 30: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 31: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 32: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

**Switch to forest-green color:**

Rnd 33: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 34: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 35 to 39: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Rnd 40: Single crochet in each stitch interspersing 1 forest-green stitch and 1 olive-green stitch.**

**Continue crocheting all stitches in olive-green color:**

Rnd 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 42: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 43: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 44: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (9 stitches).

**Switch to forest-green color:**

Rnd 45: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 46: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 47 & 48: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 49: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 50: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close. Sew the head to the top of the first body section.



### **Eyes:**

Crochet all pieces twice.

### **Eyeballs:**

The eyeballs have to be filled with stuffing while you're crocheting them. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

#### **Black color:**

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

#### **Switch to White color:**

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

#### **Switch to forest-green color:**

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 10: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 11: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

#### **Eyelids (forest-green color):**

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).  
Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).  
Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).  
Rnd 7: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).  
Fold the circle in half and join the borders with a single crochet row (21 stitches)  
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



**Eyes' assemble:** With turquoise yarn and chain stitches embroider all around the round where you've exchanged colors between black and White. Then, with white yarn embroider 2 points of light on each eye, as you can see in the picture above.



Sew the eyeballs to the head, below round 8 and leaving 3 stitches of distance from each other.



Place the eyelids overhead and a little bit above the eyes and sew them with invisible stitches.



### *Moustaches (black color):*

Make 2. The moustaches have to be filled with stuffing while you're crocheting them.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (9 stitches).

Rnd 3 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the moustaches between the eyes by one of their ends.



*Antennae (dark-green color):*

Make 2. The antennae are crocheted from top to bottom and aren't stuffed.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.



Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the antennae to the tip of the head, 2 cm (0.8 inches) behind the eyelids.

### *Feet (dark-green color):*

Make 6. The feet are crocheted from front to back and have to be filled with stuffing while they are crocheted.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: \*10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 10: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 11: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 12: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 13: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 14: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



Sew 2 feet under each body section, as you can see in the image above.



### *Hat (Brown color):*

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch

Rnd 9: Single crochet through front loops only making the following increases: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 10 & 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the hat to the left side of the tip of the head with a few stitches.

### *Bow (red color):*

The bow consists in 2 pieces: A and Main.

#### **A Piece:**

Work 6 chain stitches (do not close them into a round) and crochet around them 5 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch (16 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

#### **Main Piece:**

Work 10 chain stitches (do not close them into a round) and continue crocheting around them in spiral:

Rnd 1: 9 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch (24 stitches)

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (28 stitches).

Rnd 3: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (32 stitches).

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (36 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

With “A” you’ll make the bow’s central knot by wrapping it around the Main piece vertically in order to divide the Main piece in 2. Join A’s ends together with a few stitches.

### *Collar:*

#### **Red color:**

Work 30 chain stitches (do not close them into a circle) and crochet around them 29 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 28 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch (64 stitches). Close the round with a slip stitch and work an extra slip stitch.

#### **Switch to White color and start crocheting back and forth instead of in spiral:**

Row 1: 30 single crochet stitches.

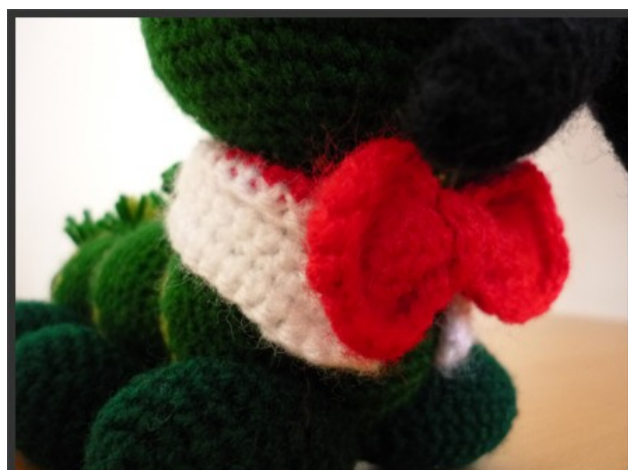
Row 2: Single crochet through back loops only making the following increases: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 26 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (32 stitches).

Row 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 4: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 28 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (34 stitches)

Row 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Wrap the collar around the caterpillar’s neck and join it ends (just the red part) with a few stitches. Then, sew the bow over the collar’s union.



## *Ending details*

Sew the head to the top of the first body section. Cut some forest-green and olive-green yarn pieces and fix 3 lines of them (2 forest-green and 1 olive-green) across the middle part of the 3 firsts body sections.

To finish the eyes, with turquoise yarn and chain stitches, embroider all around the round where you've exchanged colors between black and White. Then, with white yarn embroider 2 points of light on each eye.

Sew the eyeballs to the head, below round 8 and leaving 3 stitches of distance from each other.

Place the eyelids overhead and a little bit above the eyes and sew them with invisible stitches.

Sew the moustaches between the eyes by one of their ends.

Sew the antennae to the tip of the head, 2 cm (0.8 inches) behind the eyelids.

Sew 2 feet under each body section.

Sew the hat to the left side of the tip of the head with a few stitches.

Wrap the collar around the caterpillar's neck and join it ends (just the red part) with a few stitches. Then, sew the bow over the collar's union.
