## Grandpa

### *Materials:*

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: skin, white, black, beige, saddle-brown, dark-brown, light-mustard, green olive and dark green olive.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing, colored sewing pins and scissors.

### *Stitches used in the Project:*

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, single crochet through front loops only and double crochet.

### *Finished size:*

Height: 29 cm (11.41 inches) approx.

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# Realization

## Head (skin color):

You'll have to start stuffing this piece while you're crocheting it. You need to stuff it lightly in order to get a soft ball for being able to mark the facial features.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 26: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 27: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 28: \*6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 29: \*5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 30: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 31: \*3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 32: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 33: \*1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 34: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last row and pull tightly to close.

## Nose (skin color):

Nose (skin color): Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

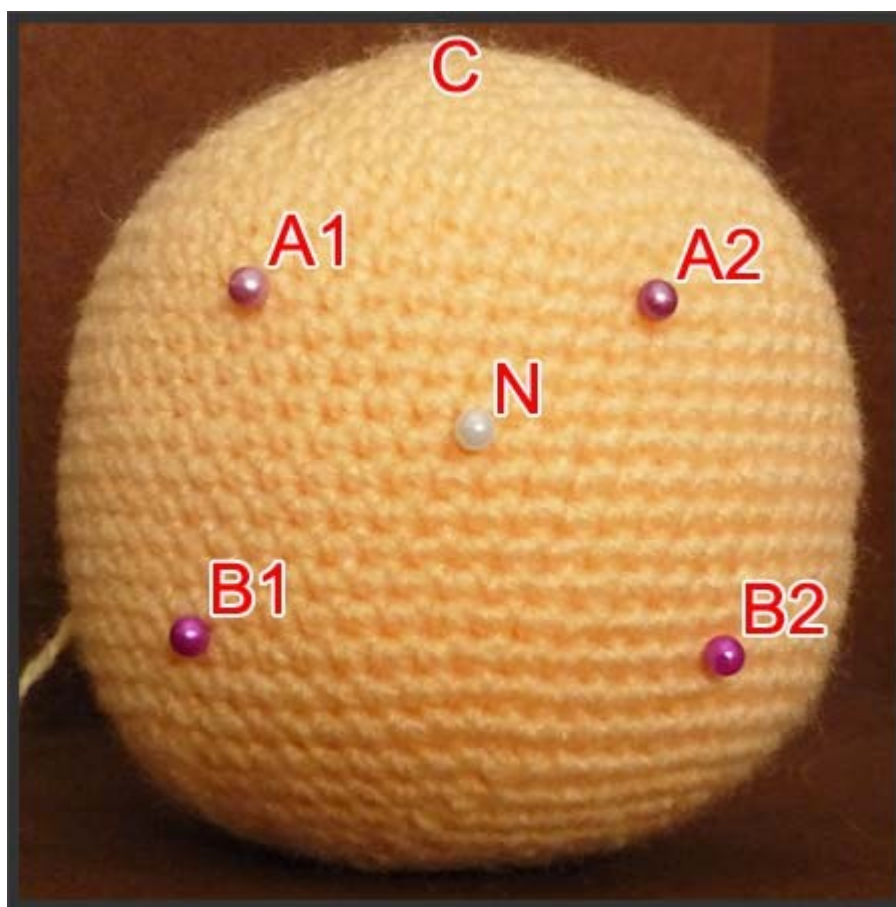
Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Put some stuffing on the center of the circle. Then with a sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last row and pull tightly to close.

To mark the facial features do as following:

With 5 colored sewing pins mark the following spots (image 1):



**A1 - A2:** These are on round 13 of the head, with 8 single crochet of distance between them. You'll sew the eyes on these spots.

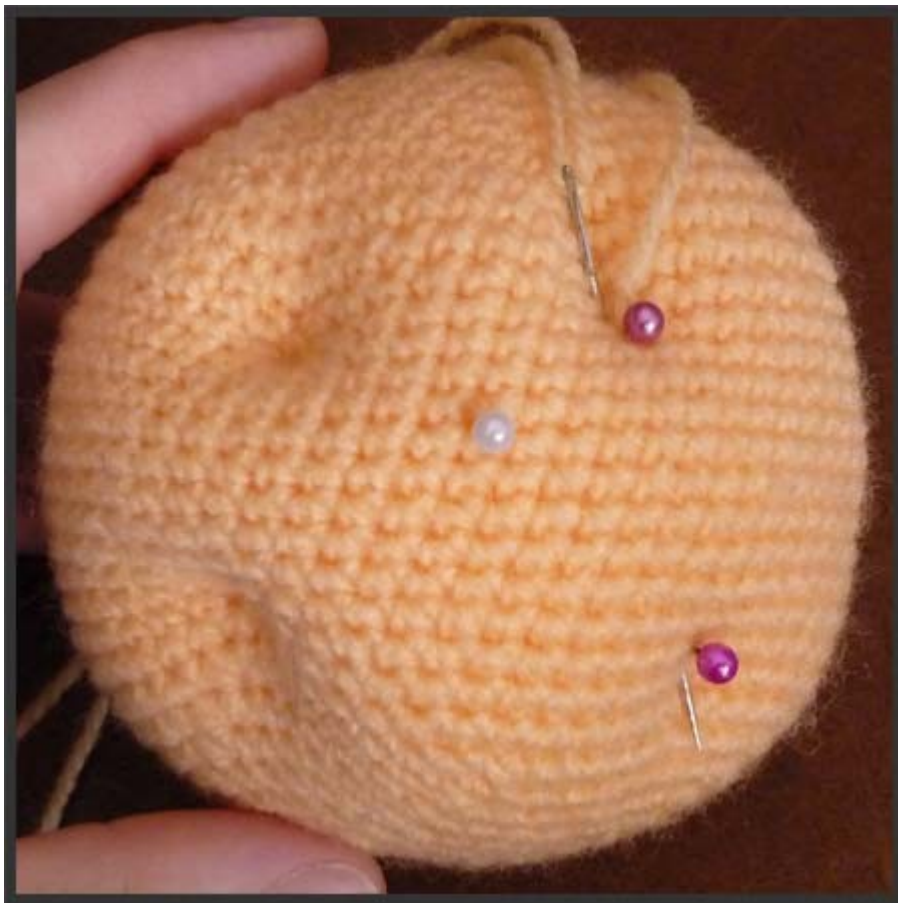
**B1 - B2:** These are on round 23 of the head, with 12 single crochet of distance between them. These spots delimit the mouth.

**N:** This is on round 17 of the head, between A1 and A2. On this spot you'll sew the nose.

Thread a tapestry needle with skin color yarn. Push the needle in C spot (this is the centre of the head's top) and through inside go down to A1.



From A1 through inside go down to B1. Repeat this procedure 3 times (image 2).



Through inside cross from B1 to A2. Then from A2 through inside go down to B2. Repeat this last procedure 3 times. (images 3 & 4).



Through outside cross from B2 to B1 and then, through inside go up from B1 to A1 (image 5).



Through inside go down from A1 to B1. Then, through outside cross from B1 to B2 and through inside go up from B2 to A2 (image 6). Through inside go up from A2 to C and make a knot.



From C through inside go down to N, sew the nose and through inside go back to C. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors (image 7).



### *Eyes (White color):*

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Put some stuffing on the center of the circle. Then with a sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last row and pull tightly to close.

**Eyes assemble:** With black yarn embroider the pupils and with White yarn embroider a point of light on each pupil. Sew the eyes to the eye orbits (spots A1 & A2).





### *Ears (skin color):*

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: \*4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 6: Join the borders with a single crochet row (5 stitches)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the ears to both sides of the head, halfway up between the eyes and mouth.



### *Feet and legs:*

Make 2. Each foot is crocheted in a single piece from bottom to top, starting from the foot sole.

### **Saddle-brown color:**

Work 10 chain stitches and continue crocheting in spiral around them:

Rnd 1: 9 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (22 stitches)

Rnd 2: \*2 single crochet in the first stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 3: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (30 stitches).

**Switch to dark-brown color:**

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (34 stitches).

Rnd 5: 13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 11 single crochet (32 stitches).

Rnd 6: 12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 10 single crochet (30 stitches).

Rnd 7: 11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 9 single crochet (28 stitches).

Rnd 8: 10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 8 single crochet (26 stitches).

Rnd 9: 9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 decrease, 7 single crochet (24 stitches).

**Switch to White color:**

Rnd 10 & 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Switch to skin color:**

Rnd 12 to 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Switch to saddle-brown color:**

Rnd 18: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (27 stitches).

Rnd 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (30 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it. Crochet the other foot and leg. Once you arrive to round 20, without cutting the yarn off, stuff the leg and join both legs with 6 single crochet. Then, continue crocheting the body around the legs.



### **Body:**

It is crocheted around the legs, starting with saddle brown color:

Rnd 21: 52 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: \*12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (56 stitches).

Rnd 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: \*13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 4 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: \*9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 28 to 33: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 34: \*20 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (63 stitches).

Rnd 35: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 36: \*19 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 38: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 39: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 40: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

### **Switch to beige color:**

Rnd 42: \*14 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 43: \*13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 44: \*12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (39 stitches).

Rnd 45: \*11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 46: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 47: \*10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (33 stitches).

Rnd 48: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 49: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 50: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 51: \*8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (27 stitches).

Rnd 52: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 53: \*7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (24 stitches).

**Switch to skin color:**

Rnd 54: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 55 & 56: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fill it with stuffing.





### *Pants (saddle-brown color):*

Make 2. The pants are crocheted directly over the legs. Just insert the hook in each stitch along the round where you've exchanged colors between skin and saddle brown:

Rnd 1: 27 single crochet.

Rnd 2: \*8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 3 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: \*9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (33 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

### *Socks' cuffs (White color):*

Make 2. You have to crochet them directly over the legs. Just insert the hook in each stitch along the round where you've exchanged colors between white and skin (between rounds 11 and 12 of the legs):

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: Double crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



### *Shirt's details:*

#### **Collar (beige color):**

The collar is crocheted directly over the body but in rows not rounds, meaning that you need to turn round your work every time you finish a row in order to start another. Just insert your hook in each stitch along the round where you've exchanged colors between beige and skin:

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2: \*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 3: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch \*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

#### **Shirt's vertical piece (beige color):**

On 10 chain stitches work a row of single crochet stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Place this piece on the front side of the body, centered between both sides of the collar.

With dark-brown yarn and French knots embroider 3 buttons on it.

### ***Belt :***

With dark-brown yarn work 70 chain stitches and crochet around them: 69 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 68 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch (142 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

#### **Belt's clasp (light-mustard color):**

Work 6 chain stitches and close them into a round. Then work 14 single crochet into the round.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Place the belt around the body, 2 rounds beneath the round where you've exchanged colors between saddle-brown and beige. Sew it with invisible stitches. On the front side of the body, over the belt, sew the belt's clasp as in the final project.



Over the body, with saddle-brown yarn and chain stitches, embroider along the row where you've exchanged colors between beige and saddle-brown. Then embroider 6 pants loops (2 on the front, 2 on the back and 1 on each side) as following: thread a tapestry needle with saddle-brown yarn and from the pants' superior border make long stitches over the belt 3 times per each loop.



### *Arms (beige color):*

Make 2: Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (16 stitches)

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (17 stitches)

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (18 stitches)

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (19 stitches)

Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (20 stitches)

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (21 stitches)

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (22 stitches).

Rnd 18 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: \*9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch

Rnd 23: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 24: Single crochet through front loops only making the following increases: \*4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 25: \*5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (21 stitches).

Rnd 26: \*6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 27: \*7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 3 times (27 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Stuff them lightly and fold up the latest rounds (from round 24) as cuffs.

### *Hands (skin color):*

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: \*1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4: \*2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: 10 single crochet, 5 double crochet closed together in the next stitch, 9 single crochet (20 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 10: \*2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 11 & 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff them. Sew each hand's opening to the arm's opening, making the stitches from the round 23 of the arm in order to get the shirt's cuffs over the hands.



*Jacket without sleeves (green olive and light-mustard colors):*

The jacket is crocheted in rows, back and forth and from bottom to top.

**Base rectangle:**

**Green olive color:**

Work 71 chain stitches and continue crocheting on them:

Row 1: 71 single crochet.

Row 2: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 5: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 2\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 6: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 7 & 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 9: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 6\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 10: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 11 & 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 13: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 10\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 14: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 15 & 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 17: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 14\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 18: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Front part A:**

For this piece you'll only have to crochet the first 17 stitches of the base rectangle:

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 1 & 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 3: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 18 (last row) of the base rectangle\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 4: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 5 & 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 7: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 4\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 8: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 9 & 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 11: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 8\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 12: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**Front part B:**

For this piece you'll only have to crochet the latest 17 stitches of the base rectangle following the same directions used for Front part A. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

**Back:**

Crochet the 23 central stitches of the base rectangle following the same directions used for Front part A & B. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Fold to the center both front parts of the jacket, matching the edges of the arm pits. Then sew 6 stitches for each shoulder.

**Collar:**

This piece is crocheted directly on the upper side of the shirt. Just crochet the 25 central stitches leaving without crocheting the 4 first and last stitches of the upper side of the jacket:

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 1 & 2: 25 single crochet.

**Green olive color:**

Row 3: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces of the latest row of the upper side of the jacket\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 4: \*1 single crochet, 1 chain stitch, skip 1 stitch from previous row\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

**Light-mustard color:**

Row 5 & 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

**Green olive color:**

Row 7: \*1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook into the chain 1 spaces from row 4\*, repeat from \*to\* till the end of the row.

Row 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With dark green olive color crochet 2 rounds of single crochet stitches all around the jacket's border and arm pits. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



## *Ending details:*

Mark the facial features following the procedure described under the title “Head”. Sew the eyes to the eye orbits and sew the nose.

Sew the ears to both sides of the head, halfway up between the eyes and mouth.

With White yarn and French knots of different sizes, embroider the hair around the head and embroider the eyebrows.

Cut some White yarn and sew them to the nose as a moustache.

Sew the body's opening underneath the head.

Place the shirt's vertical piece on the front side of the body, centered between both sides of the collar and sew it with invisible stitches. With dark-brown yarn and French knots embroider 3 buttons on it.

Place the belt around the body, 2 rounds beneath the round where you've exchanged colors between saddle-brown and beige. Sew it with invisible stitches. On the front side of the body, over the belt, sew the belt's clasp as in the final project.

Over the body, with saddle-brown yarn and chain stitches, embroider along the row where you've exchanged colors between beige and saddle-brown. Then embroider 6 pants loops (2 on the front, 2 on the back and 1 on each side) as following: thread a tapestry needle with saddle-brown yarn and from the pants' superior border make long stitches over the belt 3 times per each loop.

Sew the arms to both sides of the body, beneath the shirt collar.

With dark-brown yarn and chain stitches embroider on each foot along the rounds where you changed colors between dark-brown/saddle-brown and dark-brown/white.
