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Patterns



Freddy Krueger Tux

Materials:

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: skin, terracotta, red, green, dark-brown, light-brown, grey, black, white and yellow.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, single crochet through back loops only, single crochet through front loops only, half double crochet and front post double crochet (to crochet front post double crochet you need to insert your hook from the front side of the work around the post of each stitch from previous round and work the stitch as you're use to).

Finished size:

Height: 17.5 cm/ 6.9 inches from bottom to the tip of the hat.

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Realization



Body:

The body is crocheted from top to bottom and has to be filled with stuffing while is crocheted. To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):



Skin color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches)

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *On this round, work the front post double crochet stitches inserting the hook on round 2.*

2 single crochet, 2 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 1 front post double crochet, 1 single crochet, 1 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, repeat from *to* twice (36 stitches).

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *On this round, work the front post double crochet stitches inserting the hook on round 6.*

2 single crochet, 2 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet, 2 front post double crochet, 4 single crochet, 4 front post double crochet, repeat from *to* 3 times (48 stitches).

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 11 & 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *On this round, work the front post double crochet stitches inserting the hook on round 10.*

*4 single crochet, 4 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet, 2 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet, 2 front post double crochet *, repeat from *to* 3 times (48 stitches).

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 15 & 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: *On this round, work the front post double crochet stitches inserting the hook on round 14.*

*2 single crochet, 2 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet, 2 front post double crochet, 4 single crochet, 4 front post double crochet *, repeat from *to* 3 times (48 stitches).

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 19: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 22: *On this round, work the front post double crochet stitches inserting the hook on round 18.*

*4 single crochet, 4 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet, 3 front post double crochet, 2 single crochet, 3 front post double crochet *, repeat from *to* 3 times (54 stitches).

Switch to red color:

Rnd 23 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to green color:

Rnd 26: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 27 & 28: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 29 to 31: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to green color:

Rnd 32 & 33: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 34: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Switch to red color:

Rnd 35 to 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to dark-brown color:

Rnd 38 & 39: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 40: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 41 & 42: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 43: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 44: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 45: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 46: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 47: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 48: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 49: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Thread a tapestry needle with red yarn and embroider a chain stitches round over the round where you've exchanged colors between skin and red.



Sweater's inferior border (red color):

The sweater's inferior border is crocheted directly over the Tux's body. In order to do this, you have to insert the hook on each stitch along the round where you've exchanged colors between red and dark-brown colors.

Rnd 1: 54 single crochet. Close the round with a slip stitch.

Rnd 2: Work 2 chain stitches up and 1 double crochet in each stitch. Close the round with a slip stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Eyes:

White color:

Left eye A (big):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 8: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 9: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.

Right eye B (small):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (14 stitches)

Rnd 4: 4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (18 stitches)

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: 4 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 6 single crochet, 1 double decrease, 2 single crochet (14 stitches)

Rnd 7: 3 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet, 1

double decrease, 1 single crochet (10 stitches)

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.

Pupils (Black color):

Pupil A (big):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice, *2 half double crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice, *2 single crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Pupil B (small):

In a double adjustable ring crochet: 2 single crochet, 3 half double crochet, 2 single crochet (7 stitches)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyelids:

With **skin color** yarn work 26 chain stitches and on them crochet:

Row 1: 26 single crochet stitches.

Switch to terracotta color:

Row 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to skin color:

Row 3: *2 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook on row 1*, repeat from *to* till the end of the row (26 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Eyes' assemble: With red yarn embroider some veins all over the external part of the eyeballs' surface.



Place the eyes on the head, above the sweater's top border. The bigger eye goes on the left and the smaller eye on the right (the wider part of this eye goes across). Then sew them with invisible stitches.



Sew the pupil A on eye A and pupil B on eye B. With white yarn embroider a point of light on each pupil. Finally sew the eyelid all around the sides and top of the eyes as in the final project.



Beak (yellow color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches)

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches)

Rnd 4: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 5: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Stuff it lightly and close its opening with a few stitches. Sew the beak over the inferior part of the eyes, like in the final project.



Tail:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Skin color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 3: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches). On this round work the stitches as following: 2 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook on round 2.

Rnd 5: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 6: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 7: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 8: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches). On this round work the stitches as following: 2 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook on round 5.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it lightly. Sew the tail to the back side of the body, centered under the sweater's inferior border.



Shoes (light-brown color):

Make 2. The shoes are crocheted from front to back and have to be filled with stuffing while they're crocheted:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 20: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 21: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 22: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 23: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Place the shoes with their thinner parts under the Tux's body and sew them with invisible stitches.



Left wing:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Skin color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches)

Switch to terracotta color:

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches)

Switch to skin color:

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches)

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10 stitches). On this round work the stitches as following: 1 single crochet, 1 single crochet inserting the hook on round 2.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (11 stitches)

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches)

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (13 stitches)

Switch to green color:

Rnd 9: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (14 stitches)

Rnd 10: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (15 stitches)

Rnd 11: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (16 stitches)

Switch to red color:

Rnd 12: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (17 stitches)

Rnd 13: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (18 stitches)

Rnd 14: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (19 stitches)

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it lightly.

Sew the left wing on the left side of the body, 3 stitches behind the eye and with its superior border over the sweater's superior border.



Right wing:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Light-brown color:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3 to 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to red color:

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (11 stitches)

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches)

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (13 stitches)

Switch to green color:

Rnd 9: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (14 stitches)

Rnd 10: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (15 stitches)

Rnd 11: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (16 stitches)

Switch to red color:

Rnd 12: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (17 stitches)

Rnd 13: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (18 stitches)

Rnd 14: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (19 stitches)

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it lightly.

Razors (grey color):

Make 4. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Do not fill them with stuffing. Sew the 4 razors to the tip of the right wing, on the light-brown zone.



Sew the right wing on the right side of the body, 3 stitches behind the eye and with the razors towards up.



Hat (dark-brown color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* 5 times, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* 5 times, 4 single crochet (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 9 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: Work this round in single crochet through front loops only, doing the following increases: 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* 5 times, 3 single crochet (48 stitches).

Rnd 16: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 7 single crochet*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 17: 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch* repeat from *to* 5 times, 3 single crochet (60 stitches).

Rnd 18: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 19: 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, *10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times, 4 single crochet (72 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Place the hat over the tip of the head and if you prefer, sew it with a few stitches.

Ending details

Thread a tapestry needle with red yarn and on the body, embroider a chain stitches round over the round where you've exchanged colors between skin and red.

With red yarn embroider some veins all over the external part of the eyeballs' surface. Place the eyes on the head, above the sweater's top border. The bigger eye goes on the left and the smaller eye on the right (the wider part of this eye goes across). Then sew them with invisible stitches.

Sew the pupil A on eye A and pupil B on eye B. With white yarn embroider a point of light on each pupil. Finally sew the eyelid all around the sides and top of the eyes.

Sew the beak over the inferior part of the eyes, like in the final project.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body, centered under the sweater's inferior border.

Place the shoes with their thinner parts under the Tux's body and sew them with invisible stitches.

Sew the left wing on the left side of the body, 3 stitches behind the eye and with its superior border over the sweater's superior border.

Sew the 4 razors to the tip of the right wing, on the light-brown zone. Sew the right wing on the right side of the body, 3 stitches behind the eye and with the razors towards up.

Place the hat over the tip of the head and if you prefer, sew it with a few stitches.
