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Patterns



Mr. Mosquito

Materials:

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: green olive, brown, light brown, white and black.
C hook (2.5 mm), a sewing needle for yarn, scissors and stuffing.

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, single crochet, single crochet through back loops only, half double crochet and double crochet.

Finished size:

Height: 18.5 cm approx.

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Realization

Head (green olive color):

You'll have to start stuffing this piece while you're crocheting it, in order to avoid inconvenience. To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 5 Single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: 2 single crochet in the first stitch from last round, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches)

Rnd 17: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 18: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 19: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 20: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 21: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 22: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 23: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 28 to 31: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 32: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 33: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 34: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 35: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 36: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last row and pull tightly to close.



Eyes:

Big eyeball (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 7: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Small eyeball (White color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Big pupil (black color):

In a double adjustable ring crochet: 2 single crochet, 3 half double crochet, 2 single crochet (7 stitches)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Small pupil (black color):

In a double adjustable ring crochet 5 single crochet stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyebrows (black color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last row and pull tightly to close.

Eyes assemble: Sew the eyeballs to the mosquito's head above the proboscis, placing the bigger on the right and the smaller on the left.

In the front side of each eyeball sew the pupils (the big one on the right eye and the small on the left eye). Both pupils must be looking to the front.

With white yarn embroider a point of light on each pupil.

Fold the eyebrow in half and sew its centre between the eyes (the eyebrow will be in a V shape)



Chest (green olive color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).
 Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Rnd 9: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).
 Rnd 10 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Rnd 15: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).
 Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Rnd 17: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).
 Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Rnd 19: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).
 Rnd 20: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).
 Rnd 21: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).
 Rnd 22 & 23: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the chest's opening to the head, beneath it, 2.5 cm from the proboscis base.



Abdomen (green olive color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:
 Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.
 Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).
 Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Rnd 4: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).
 Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.
 Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 15 to 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 19 & 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it. Sew the abdomen's opening to the chest's bottom and facing back. The inferior border of the abdomen's opening should pass through the centre of the inferior part of the chest.



Wings (White color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 16 & 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 19 & 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 22 & 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Join the borders with a single crochet row (6 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew both wings to the mosquito's back, 1.5 cm beneath the union between the head and chest and 2 cm above the union of the chest and abdomen.



Hands and arms (brown color):

Make 2. These pieces are crocheted from bottom to top, starting with the hands. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: 7 single crochet, 4 double crochet closed together in the next stitch, 6 single crochet (14 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: 7 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 7 times) (7 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff them lightly. Sew the arms to both sides of the chest as in the final project.

Feet and legs (brown color):

Make 2. These pieces are crocheted from bottom to top, starting from the feet's soles. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 6: 6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 6 single crochet (22 stitches).

Rnd 7: 5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 5 single crochet (20 stitches).

Rnd 8: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (18 stitches).

Rnd 9: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times, 3 single crochet (15 stitches)

Rnd 10: 2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 2 single crochet (11 stitches).

Row 11 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff them. Sew the legs to the bottom of the chest, in front of the union between the chest and abdomen.



Ending details:

Sew the eyeballs to the mosquito's head above the proboscis, placing the bigger on the right and the smaller on the left.

In the front side of each eyeball sew the pupils (the big one on the right eye and the small on the left eye). Both pupils must be looking to the front.

With white yarn embroider a point of light on each pupil.

Fold the eyebrow in half and sew its centre between the eyes (the eyebrow will be in a V shape)

Cut some pieces of green olive and brown yarn and fix them as hair on the top of the mosquito's head.

Sew the chest's opening to the head, beneath it, 2.5 cm from the proboscis base.

Sew the abdomen's opening to the chest's bottom and facing back. The inferior border of the abdomen's opening should pass through the centre of the inferior part of the chest.

With light brown yarn and chain stitches embroider circles all around the abdomen.

Sew both wings to the mosquito's back, 1.5 cm beneath the union between the head and chest and 2 cm above the union of the chest and abdomen.

Sew the arms to both sides of the chest and then sew the legs to the bottom of the chest, in front of the union between the chest and abdomen.
