Donnie, The Mouse

Materials:

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: gray, pink, white, black, brown and yellow.
C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, single crochet and half double crochet.

Finished size:

Height: 20 cm/ 7.88 inches tall

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Realization



Head (gray color):

The head is crocheted from muzzle to back of the head. You have to fill this piece with stuffing while you're crocheting it.

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 18 to 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 22: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 23: 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet (26 stitches)

Rnd 24: 11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet (28 stitches)

Rnd 25: 12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet (30 stitches)

Rnd 26: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).
Rnd 27: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 28: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).
Rnd 29 to 34: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 35: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).
Rnd 36: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).
Rnd 37: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).
Rnd 38: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).
Rnd 39: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).
Rnd 40: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Eyes:

Crochet all pieces twice.



Eyeballs (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 6: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff them.



Iris (Brown color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice, *2 half double crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice, *2 single crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Pupil (black color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet 2 single crochet, 3 half double crochet, 2 single crochet (7 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Eyelids (gray color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Fold the circle in half and join the borders with a single crochet row (15 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyes assemble: Sew the eyeballs between rounds 23 to 25 of the head, letting 2 stitches of distance between them. Then, on the front side of the eyeballs, sew the irises first (brown circle) and then the pupils.

Place the eyelids over the tip and external part of the eyeballs and sew them with invisible stitches.

Thread a tapestry needle with white yarn and embroider a point of light on each eye, placing them on the external border of the pupil, between the pupil and the iris.

Nose (pink color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 7: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing. Sew the nose to the tip of the muzzle.



Ears (pink color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 8: *15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (34 stitches).

Rnd 9: *16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (36 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *16 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (34 stitches).

Rnd 16: *15 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 17: *14 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (30 stitches).

Rnd 18: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 19: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times

(18 stitches).



Join the borders with single crochet row (9 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the ears on round 32 on the head, letting 9 stitches of distance between them.



Body (gray color):

The body is crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the legs.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (21 stitches).

Rnd 6: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 7: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (27 stitches).

Rnd 8: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Crochet the other leg following the same directions. Once you've finished round 9 of the second leg, without cutting the yarn off, join both legs with 6 single crochet (this is the mouse's crotch) and continue crocheting the body around the legs:

Rnd 10: 52 single crochet.

Rnd 11 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (44 stitches).

Rnd 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 24 to 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (32 stitches).

Rnd 28 to 30: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 31: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (28 stitches).

Rnd 32 to 34: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 35: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 36: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 37: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 38: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it.



Sew the body's opening to the bottom of the head, behind round 23 of the head.



Feet (pink color):

Make 2. The feet are crocheted from front to back and have to be stuffed while you're crocheting them.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 19: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 20: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 21: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 22: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 23: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 24: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Thread a tapestry needle with pink yarn and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little. Repeat this procedure twice in order to mark 3 toes. Then sew the feet to the underneath the legs.



Arms (Make 2):

The arms are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the hands.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Pink color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 4: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 5 & 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to gray color:

Rnd 9 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 22 & 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 24: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Stuff them lightly and then join the borders with a single crochet row (8 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Mark 3 fingers on each hand using the same procedure used to mark the toes. Then, place the arms on each side of the body and sew their last row over the union between head and body, as you can see in the image.



Tail (pink color):

The tail is crocheted from top to bottom and has to be stuffed lightly while you're crocheting it. Also, you can wire it in order to make it posable, but is not recommended if the mouse is for children.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches)

Rnd 7 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches)

Rnd 12 to 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 18: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches)

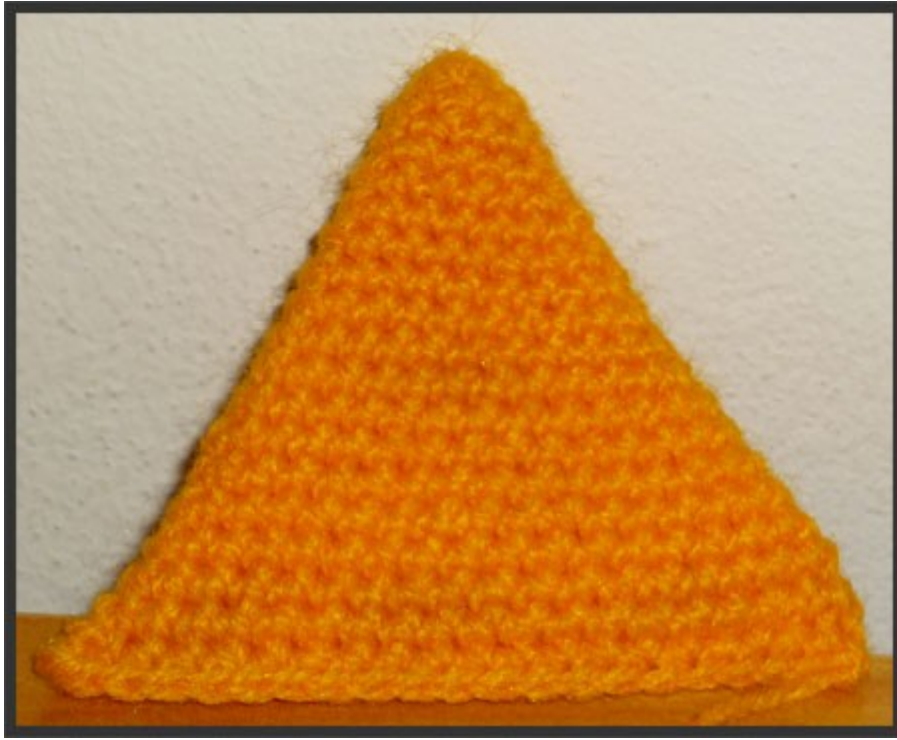
Rnd 19 to 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: 2 single crochet in the first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches)

Rnd 29 to 53: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the tail to the bottom of the mouse's back, centered between the legs.



Cheese (yellow color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 3: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 5: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 6: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 7: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 8: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 9: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 10: *10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 11: *11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 12: *12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 13: *13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (30 stitches).

Rnd 14: *14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 15: *15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (34 stitches).

Rnd 16: *16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (36 stitches).

Rnd 17: *17 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (38 stitches).

Rnd 18: *18 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (40 stitches).

Join the borders with a single crochet row (20 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the cheese to the mouse's hands.



Ending details

Sew the eyeballs between rounds 23 to 25 of the head, letting 2 stitches of distance between them.

Then, on the front side of the eyeballs, sew the irises first (brown circle) and then the pupils.

Place the eyelids over the tip and external part of the eyeballs and sew them with invisible stitches.

Thread a tapestry needle with white yarn and embroider a point of light on each eye, placing them on the external border of the pupil, between the pupil and the iris.

Sew the nose to the tip of the muzzle.

With pink yarn embroider a small mouth on a side of the muzzle.

Sew the ears on round 32 on the head, letting 9 stitches of distance between them.

Sew the body's opening to the bottom of the head, behind round 23 of the head.

Thread a tapestry needle with pink yarn and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little. Repeat this procedure twice in order to mark 3 toes. Then sew the feet to the underneath the legs.

Mark 3 fingers on each hand using the same procedure used to mark the toes. Then, place the arms on each side of the body and sew their last row over the union between head and body.

Sew the tail to the bottom of the mouse's back, centered between the legs.

Sew the cheese to the mouse's hands.
