Bunny Rabbits

Materials:

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: white, beige, pale pink, cerise, pink, fuchsia, black, orange, dark-green, brown, light-green and yellow.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing, colored sewing pins and scissors.

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, single crochet, single crochet through back loops only, back post single crochet, front post single crochet, half double crochet and crab stitch (reverse single crochet: Working left to right, insert hook in next stitch to the right, complete as single crochet).

Finished size:

Big Bunny Rabbit (white): 18 cm/7.1 inches from bottom to tip of ears

Small Bunny Rabbit (beige and white): 13 cm/5.12 inches from bottom to tip of ears

Carrot: 10 cm/4 inches length

Basket: 7 cm/2.75 inches de diameter; 10 cm/4 inches from bottom to top of handle.

Lawn: 30 cm/12 inches diameter

Realization



Bíg Bunny Rabbít: Head (Whíte color):

The head is crocheted from top to bottom. To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 20: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 21: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 22: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 23: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.



Muzzle (White color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it lightly. Sew the muzzle to the head with its superior border under round 13.

Thread a tapestry needle with White yarn and make a long straight stitch from the centre of the muzzle's inferior border to a round above the muzzle's centre, pulling tight but with careful, in order to divide the muzzle in 2 parts. Repeat this procedure 3 times and make a knot. Then, with pale pink yarn embroider the nose in a triangular shape.



Eyes:

Crochet all pieces twice.

Eveball:

The eyeballs must be filled with stuffing while you're crocheting them. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Pink color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Switch to White color:

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 6: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Iris (cerise color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice, *2 half double crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice, *2 single crochet in each stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Pupil (fuchsia color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet 2 single crochet, 3 half double crochet, 2 single crochet (7 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Eyes assemble: Place the eyeballs to both sides of the muzzle and sew them. On the front side of the eyeballs and near the muzzle, sew the irises first and then the pupils, matching their internal borders. Thread a tapestry needle with white yarn and embroider 2 points of light on each eye, placing them on the external border of the pupil, between the pupil and the iris.

Ears (Make 2):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

White color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since round 6 we'll start crocheting the pink shade of the ears:

Rnd 6 & 7: 8 white single crochet, 2 pale pink single crochet, 8 white single crochet (18 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 11: 7 white single crochet, 4 pale pink single crochet, 7 white single crochet (18 stitches)

Rnd 12 to 15: 6 **white** single crochet, 6 **pale pink** single crochet, 6 **white** single crochet (18 stitches)

Rnd 16: 18 white single crochet.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fold the ears in half vertically (over the pink shade) and sew the base of the ears as you can see in the following images. Then sew the ears to the top of the head between rounds 5 and 6.



Body (White color):

The body is crocheted from bottom to top. Into A double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches). Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since this round you're going to start shaping the back's curvature:

Rnd 12: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times, 15 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (36 stitches)

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times, 14 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (30 stitches)

Rnd 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times, 13 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* twice, 1 decrease (24 stitches)

Rnd 17 & 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 12 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (22 stitches)

Rnd 20: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 10 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (20 stitches)

Rnd 21: 4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 4 single crochet (18 stitches)

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it. Sew the body's opening to the heads opening placing the back's curvature to the back.



Feet (White color):

Make 2. The feet are crocheted from front to back and must be stuffed while you're crocheting them.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches).

Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 20: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close. Sew the feet underneath the body. Thread a tapestry needle with white yarn and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little hard and making a knot to keep it firm, repeating this procedure twice in order to mark 3 toes.

Arms (White color):

Make 2. The arms are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the hands and must be stuffed while you're crocheting them (stuff them lightly).

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 5: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 4: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 5 & 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Close the arm's opening crocheting a single crochet row (6 single crochet). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the arms to both sides of the body, beneath the union between head and body.

Mark 3 fingers on each hand following the same procedure used to mark the toes.

Tail (White color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round. Put some stuffing inside the tail and pull the yarn tightly to close. Sew the tail to the rabbit's back.



Small Bunny Rabbit: Head (beige color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 15: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 16: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 17: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.



Muzzle (White color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it lightly. Sew the muzzle to the head with its superior border under round 10.

Thread a tapestry needle with White yarn and make a long straight stitch from the centre of the

muzzle's inferior border to a round above the muzzle's centre, pulling tight but with careful, in order to divide the muzzle in 2 parts. Repeat this procedure 3 times and make a knot. Then, with pale pink yarn embroider the nose in a triangular shape.

Eyeballs (Make 2):

White color:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Switch to beige color:

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them with stuffing. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Eyes assemble: Place the eyeballs to both sides of the muzzle and sew them. Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and on the front side of the eyeballs and near the muzzle, embroider the irises. Then, with white yarn embroider 2 points of light on each eye.



Ears (make 2):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Beige color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Since round 5 we'll start crocheting the pink shade of the ears:

Rnd 5 & 6: 6 beige single crochet, 1 pale pink single crochet, 5 beige single crochet (12 stitches).

Rnd 7 to 10: 5 beige single crochet, 3 pale pink single crochet, 4 beige single crochet (12 stitches)

Rnd 11: 12 beige single crochet.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the ears to the top of the bunny's head, between rounds 3 and 4 using the same procedure used for sewing the ears of the big bunny.

Body:

The body is crocheted from bottom to top. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Beige color:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: With beige color crochet *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice, 1 single crochet (11 beige stitches). Switch to white color and crochet: 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (8 white stitches). Switch to beige color and crochet 1 single crochet in the same stitch where you've crocheted the last White stitch,*3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (11 beige stitches) (30 stitches at the end of the round).

Rnd 6 & 7: 10 beige single crochet, 10 white single crochet, 10 beige single crochet (30 stitches) Since this round you're going to start shaping the back's curvature:

Rnd 8: With beige color crochet *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice, 1 single crochet. Switch to White color and crochet 8 single crochet stitches. Switch to beige color and crochet 1 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 3 single crochet * repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches)

Rnd 9: With beige color crochet *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice, 1 single crochet. Switch to white color and crochet 8 single crochet. Switch to beige color and crochet 1 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet * repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches)

Rnd 10: With beige color crochet *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* twice, 2 single crochet. Switch to white color and crochet 6 single crochet.

Switch to beige color and crochet 2 single crochet. *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)

Switch to beige color and crochet 2 single crochet, *1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet * repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches)

Rnd 11: 7 beige single crochet, 4 white single crochet, 7 beige single crochet (18 stitches) Since round 12 we'll start crocheting all stitches with beige color:

Rnd 12: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 13: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it. Sew the body's opening to the heads opening placing the back's curvature to the back and the White zone to the front.



Feet (beige color):

Make 2. The feet are crocheted from front to back and must be stuffed while you're crocheting them.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close. Sew the feet underneath the body. Thread a tapestry needle with beige yarn and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little hard and making a knot to keep it firm, repeating this procedure twice in order to mark 3 toes.

Arms (beige color):

Make 2. The arms are crocheted from bottom to top, starting on the hands and must me stuffed while you're crocheting them (stuff them lightly).

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Close the arm's opening crocheting a single crochet row (5 single crochet). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the arms to both sides of the body, beneath the union between head and body.

Mark 3 fingers on each hand following the same procedure used to mark the toes.

Tail (beige color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round. Put some stuffing inside the tail and pull the yarn tightly to close. Sew the tail to the rabbit's back.



Basket (brown color):

The whole basket is crocheted in single crochet stitches through back loops only, except on those rounds specified on the pattern.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: Crochet this round in back post single crochet (insert your hook from the back side of the work around the post of each stitch from previous round) making the following increases: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: Crochet this round in front post single crochet (insert your hook from the front side of the work around the post of each stitch from previous round) without increases.

Rnd 18: Crochet this round in crab stitch (reverse single crochet) without increases.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Basket Handle (Brown color):

Work 30 chain stitches and continue crocheting around them:

Rnd 1: 29 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 28 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch (64 stitches).

Rnd 2: Crochet this round in crab stitch (reverse single crochet) without increases.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Sew the handle to the basket as in the final project.



Carrot (orange color):

The carrot is crocheted from top to bottom and must be filled with stuffing while you're crocheting it. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 8 & 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 11 & 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 14 & 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 17 & 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: 4 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 4 times) (4 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Carrot leaves (dark-green color):

Work 6 chain stitches and on them crochet:

Row 1: *1 single crochet, 1 leaf**, 1 single crochet*, repeat from *to* till the end of the row.

**Leaf: work 6 chain stitches and on them crochet a single crochet row.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn

around each stitch, pull tightly and close it into a circle.

Sew the leaves to the top of the carrot (that's the wider part of the carrot). Thread a tapestry needle with brown yarn and embroider some horizontal lines all around the carrot's surface.



Lawn (light-green color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 12: *10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (72 stitches).

Rnd 13: *11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (78 stitches).

Rnd 14: *12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (84 stitches).

Rnd 15: *13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (90 stitches).

Rnd 16: *14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (96 stitches).

Rnd 17: *15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (102 stitches).

Rnd 18: *16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (108 stitches).

That 10. 10 single crocket, 2 single crocket in next stick, repeat from to 0 times (100 stickets)

Rnd 19: *17 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (114 stitches).

Rnd 20: *18 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (120 stitches).

Rnd 21: *19 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (126 stitches).

Rnd 22: *20 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (132 stitches).

Rnd 23: *21 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (138 stitches).

Rnd 24: *22 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (144 stitches).

Rnd 25: *23 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (150 stitches).

Rnd 26: *24 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (156 stitches).

Rnd 27: *25 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (162 stitches).

Rnd 28: *26 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (168 stitches).

Rnd 29: *27 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (174 stitches).

Rnd 30: *28 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (180 stitches).

Rnd 31: *1 single crochet, 3 chains and 2 double crochet, skip 2 stitches from last round*, repeat from *to* till the end of the round.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Ending details

Big Bunny Rabbit (white):

Sew the muzzle to the head with its superior border under round 13. Thread a tapestry needle with White yarn and make a long straight stitch from the centre of the muzzle's inferior border to a round above the muzzle's centre, pulling tight but with careful, in order to divide the muzzle in 2 parts. Repeat this procedure 3 times and make a knot. Then, with pale pink yarn embroider the nose in a triangular shape.

Place the eyeballs to both sides of the muzzle and sew them. On the front side of the eyeballs and near the muzzle, sew the irises first and then the pupils, matching their internal borders. Thread a tapestry needle with white yarn and embroider 2 points of light on each eye, placing them on the external border of the pupil, between the pupil and the iris.

Sew the ears to the top of the head between rounds 5 and 6.

Sew the body's opening to the heads opening placing the back's curvature to the back.

Sew the feet underneath the body. Thread a tapestry needle with white yarn and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little hard and making a knot to keep it firm, repeating this procedure twice in order to mark 3 toes.

Sew the arms to both sides of the body, beneath the union between head and body. Mark 3 fingers on each hand following the same procedure used to mark the toes.

Sew the tail to the back side of the rabbit's body.

Small Bunny Rabbit (beige and white):

Sew the muzzle to the head with its superior border under round 10. Thread a tapestry needle with White yarn and make a long straight stitch from the centre of the muzzle's inferior border to a round above the muzzle's centre, pulling tight but with careful, in order to divide the muzzle in 2 parts. Repeat this procedure 3 times and make a knot. Then, with pale pink yarn embroider the nose in a triangular shape.

Place the eyeballs to both sides of the muzzle and sew them. Thread a tapestry needle with black yarn and on the front side of the eyeballs and near the muzzle, embroider the irises. Then, with white yarn embroider 2 points of light on each eye.

Sew the ears to the top of the bunny's head, between rounds 3 and 4 using the same procedure used for sewing the ears of the big bunny.

Sew the body's opening to the heads opening placing the back's curvature to the back and the White zone to the front.

Sew the feet underneath the body. Thread a tapestry needle with beige yarn and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little hard and making a knot to keep it firm, repeating this procedure twice in order to mark 3 toes.

Sew the arms to both sides of the body, beneath the union between head and body. Mark 3 fingers on each hand following the same procedure used to mark the toes.

Sew the tail to the back side of the rabbit's body.

Basket:

Sew the handle to the basket as in the final Project.

Carrot:

Sew the leaves to the top of the carrot (that's the wider part of the carrot). Thread a tapestry needle with brown yarn and embroider some horizontal lines all around the carrot's surface.

Lawn:

Cut some light green yarn and dark green yarn and fix them in groups of 4 pieces in different places over the lawn's surface.

With yellow, orange and pink yarn embroider rococo flowers (single flowers and groups of three) in different places over the lawn surface. Each flower consists in 3 parallel french knots.
