Santa Tux and his Elves

Materials:

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: black, white, yellow, red, spring-green, dark-brown and light-brown.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing and scissors.

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet and half double crochet.

Finished size:

Santa Tux: 12 cm (4.7 inches) approx (without hat)

Elves: 6 cm (2.35 inches) approx (without hat)

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Realization



Santa Tux:

Head (black color):

To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fill it with stuffing.

Body (red color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8 & 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 14: *15 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (51 stitches).

Rnd 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 16: *16 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 17: *17 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (57 stitches).

Rnd 18: *18 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 19: *18 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (57 stitches).

Rnd 20: *17 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 21: *16 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (51 stitches).

Rnd 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: *15 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing. Sew the body's opening to the head's opening.



Suit's details (white color):

Jacket's collar:

The collar is crocheted in rows back and forth (do not close the row into a round with a slip stitch), not in spiral. This means that every time you finish a row, you need to turn around your work in order to start another row.

In order to crochet the collar, you just need to insert your hook in every stitch along the last round over the union between the head and body:

Row 1: 48 single crochet stitches.

Row 2: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Row 3: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Row 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Jacket's inferior border:

This piece is crocheted in rows back and forth (do not close the row into a round with a slip stitch), not in spiral. This means that every time you finish a row, you need to turn around the work in order to start another row.

In order to crochet the jacket's inferior border you just need to insert your hook in every stitch along round 10 of the body:

Row 1: 45 single crochet stitches.

Row 2: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (50 stitches).

Row 3: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (55 stitches).

Row 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Jacket's vertical piece:

Work 12 chain stitches and on them crochet 2 rows of single crochet stitches. Make a knot and cut

the yarn with scissors.

Place the jacket's vertical piece on the body's front and sew it with invisible stitches.



Belt (dark-brown color):

Work 60 chain stitches and on them crochet single crochet row. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Place the belt around the body, over the jacket's inferior border and sew it with invisible stitches.

Belt's clasp (yellow color):

Work 5 chain stitches and close them into a circle with a slip stitch. Inside the circle crochet 10 single crochet stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the clasp to the belt's front side.



Eyes:

White color:

Left eye (big):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 6: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.

Right eye (small):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches

Rnd 2: * 2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (14 stitches)

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.

Iris (black color):

Left iris (big):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet: 2 single crochet, 3 half double crochet and 2 single crochet (7 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Right iris (small):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet: 2 single crochet, 2 half double crochet and 1 single crochet (5 stitches). Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyelid (black color):

Work 23 chain stitches and on them crochet 2 rows of single crochet.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyes assemble: With invisible stitches sew the iris to each eyeball. With white yarn embroider a point of light on the top of each iris. Place the eyes on the head, above the jacket's collar. The bigger eye goes on the left and the smaller eye on the right (the wider part of this eye goes across). Then sew them with invisible stitches. Sew the eyelid all around the sides and top of the eyes as in the final project.

Beak (yellow color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 puntos).

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches).

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Stuff it lightly and sew it over the bottom of the eyes like in the final project.



Tail (black color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 3: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 5: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 6: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 7: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Stuff it lightly and sew it to the back side of the body, under the jacket's inferior border.



Wings (Make 2)::

Black color:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 puntos).

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches).

Switch to red color:

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10

stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (11 stitches).

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (12 stitches).

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (13 stitches).

Rnd 9: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (14 stitches).

Rnd 10: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (15 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

With White yarn crochet the sleeves' cuffs directly over the wings. You just need to insert your hook in every stitch along round 4 of the wing (the latest black round):

Rnd 1: 9 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Stuff them lightly and sew them to both sides of the body under the jacket's collar.



Hat:

Red color:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 11: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).
Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 13: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).
Switch to White color:
Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 15: *14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (32 stitches).
Rnd 16 & 17: Single crochet in each stitch.
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fold up the white part of the hat. Sew the hat to the Tux's head making the stitches from the first white round.
With White yarn embroider some french knots on the top of the hat as a pompom.

Boots (dark-brown color):

Make 2. You need to start stuffing the boots while you're crocheting them.
Into a double adjustable ring crochet:
Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.
Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).
Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).
Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).
Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).
Rnd 6 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 9: *13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).
Rnd 10: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).
Rnd 11: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (24 stitches).
Rnd 12: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (22 stitches).
Rnd 13: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (20 stitches).
Rnd 14: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (18 stitches).
Rnd 15: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).
Rnd 16: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).
Rnd 17: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).
Rnd 18: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).
Rnd 19: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).
Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.
Place the boots with their thinner parts under the Tux's body and sew them with invisible stitches.



Bag (dark-brown color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 18 to 22: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 23: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (20 stitches)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Stuff it lightly and tie it with a piece of light-brown yarn.



Elf:

Head/Body (black color):

You need to start stuffing this piece while you're crocheting it. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 8: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 20: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 21: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.



Belly (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Place the belly on the front side of the body (with its inferior border touching penultimate round of the body) and sew it with invisible stitches.



Eyes (White color):

Left eye (big):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (10 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 4: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing.

Right eye (small):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 4 single crochet

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (8 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 4: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (8 stitches).

Eyelid (black color):

Work 15 chain stitches and on them crochet 2 rows of single crochet stitches. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyes assemble: Place the eyes in the front side of the body with their lower halves over the belly. The bigger eye goes on the left and the smaller eye on the right. Then sew them with invisible stitches. Sew the eyelid all around the sides and top of the eyes as in the final project.

With black yarn embroider the iris on both eyes and with White yarn embroider a point of light on each iris.

Beak (yellow color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 4 single crochet.

Rnd 2: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (6 stitches).

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Without stuffing it, close the beak's opening with a couple of stitches and sew it over the bottom of the eyes.



Tail (black color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (8 stitches).

Rnd 3: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Do not fill it with stuffing.

Sew the tail to the elf's back side of the body.

Wings (black color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8 stitches).

Rnd 4: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (9 stitches).

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (10 stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (11 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Do not fill them with stuffing.

Sew the wings to both sides of the body on round 10.



Shoes (Make 2):

The shoes can be crocheted in 1 color (spring-green) or in stripes (red and white). If you wish to crochet them in stripes, just crochet 2 rounds in red and 2 rounds in white, starting with red color. You need to start stuffing the shoes while you're crocheting them.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 & 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 6: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (16 stitches).

Rnd 7: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 8: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 9: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 10: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Place the shoes with their thinner parts under the elf's body and sew them with invisible stitches.



Hat:

The hat can be crocheted in one color (spring-green) or in stripes (red and white). The instructions have been written for the spring-green hat, but if you wish to crochet it in stripes crochet 2 rounds in red and 2 rounds in White (starting with red color) and since round 15 till the end, crochet with spring-green color.

Spring-green color:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (6 stitches).

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (7 stitches).

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch till the end of the round (8

stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (10 stitches).

Rnd 10: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 11: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 12: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (16 stitches).

Rnd 13: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 14: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (24 stitches).

Switch to red color:

Rnd 15: *11 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 16 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knob and cut the yarn with scissors. Fold up the red part of the hat. Sew the hat to the elf's head.

With red yarn embroider some french knots on the top of the hat as a pompom.

Ending details



Santa Tux

Sew the head's opening to the body's opening.

Once you've finished crocheting the jacket's collar and inferior border, place the jacket's vertical piece on the body's front and sew it with invisible stitches.

Place the belt around the body, over the jacket's inferior border and sew it with invisible stitches.

Sew the belt's clasp on the belt's front part.

To assemble the eyes, first with invisible stitches sew the iris to each eyeball. With white yarn embroider a point of light on the top of each iris. Place the eyes on the head, above the jacket's collar. The bigger eye goes on the left and the smaller eye on the right (the wider part of this eye goes across). Then sew them with invisible stitches. Sew the eyelid all around the sides and top of the eyes as in the final project.

Sew the beak over the bottom of the eyes. Then cut some pieces of white yarn and sew them to the back side of the beak as a beard.

Sew the tail to the back side of the body, under the jacket's inferior border.

Sew the wings to both sides of the body under the jacket's collar.

Fold up the white part of the hat. Then sew the hat to the Tux's head, making the stitches from the first white round.

With White yarn embroider some french knots on the top of the hat as a pompom.

Place the boots with their thinner parts under the Tux's body and sew them with invisible stitches.



Elf:

Place the belly on the front side of the body (with its inferior border touching the penultimate round of the body) and sew it with invisible stitches.

Place the eyes in the front side of the body with their lower halves over the belly. The bigger eye goes on the left and the smaller eye on the right. Then sew them with invisible stitches. Sew the eyelid all around the sides and top of the eyes as in the final project.

With black yarn embroider the iris on both eyes and with White yarn embroider a point of light on each iris.

Without stuffing the beak close the its opening with a couple of stitches and sew it over the bottom of the eyes.

Sew the tail to the elf's back side of the body and the wings to both sides of the body on round 10.

Place the shoes with their thinner parts under the elf's body and sew them with invisible stitches.

Fold up the red part of the hat. Then sew the hat to the elf's head making the stitches from the first red round.

With red yarn embroider some french knots on the top of the hat as a pompom.
