Elton, The Sheep

Materials:

Remains of acrylic yarn in the following colors: beige, white, black and dark-brown.
C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing, colored sewing pins and scissors.

Stitches used in the Project:

Double adjustable ring, single crochet, single crochet through back loops only, half double crochet and loop stitch ([Video Tutorial](#)).

Finished size:

Height: 27 cm (10.7 inches) sit; 36 cm (14.2 inches) stand

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Loop Stitch Tutorial

How to crochet Loop Stitch:

Start with a row (or round) of single crochet stitches.

Step 1:



Insert the hook in the first stitch. Form a loop wrapping the yarn clockwise around your left index finger.



Rotate your hook in the opposite direction from the way you usually would. It goes over the yarn first and then behind both sides of the loop.

Step 2:



Catch both sides of the loop and pass them through the stitch where you inserted the hook in step 1.



Now you'll have the hook in the front side of the work with 3 loops on it and 1 loop in the back side of the work.



Yarn over the hook (you'll have 4 loops on the hook) and pass the strand through the other 3 loops on your hook to finish the stitch.



Step 3:

Repeat steps 1 & 2 till the end of the row.

Realization



Head:

The head consists in 2 pieces sewed together: Top of the head (white) and muzzle (beige)

Top of the head (white color):

This piece is crocheted interspersing single crochet rounds (odd rounds) and loop stitch rounds (pair rounds). To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 loop stitches in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9 to 16: Crochet these rounds without increases interspersing single crochet rounds (odd rounds) and loop stitch rounds (pair rounds).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and stuff it.

Muzzle (beige color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

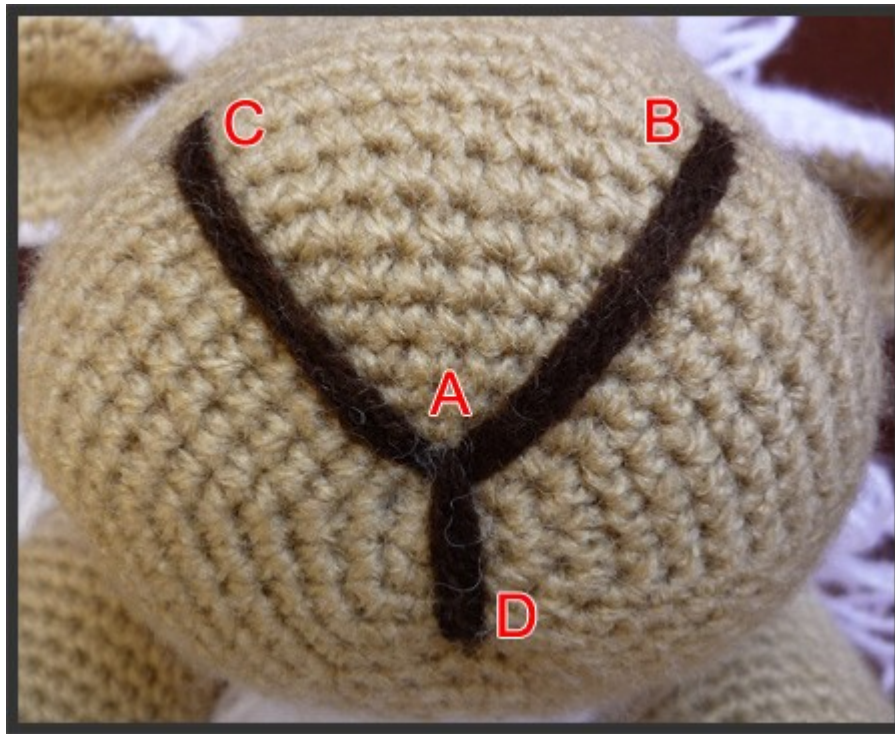
Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).
Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).
Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).
Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).
Rnd 10: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).
Rnd 11: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).
Rnd 12 to 15: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 16: *31 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (64 stitches).
Rnd 17: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 18: *30 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (62 stitches).
Rnd 19: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 20: *29 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (60 stitches).
Rnd 21: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 22: *28 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (58 stitches).
Rnd 23: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 24: *27 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (56 stitches).
Rnd 25: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (52 stitches).
Rnd 26: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (48 stitches).
Rnd 27: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).
Rnd 28: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).
Rnd 29 to 34: Single crochet in each stitch.
Rnd 35: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).
Rnd 36: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).
Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it with stuffing. Sew together the top of the head and muzzle by their openings in order to assemble the head.



With dark-brown yarn embroider the nose into a “Y” shape. With 4 colored sewing pins mark the following spots:

A: This is the nose’s centre and it’s placed on round 2.

B & C: Both are placed on round 15. There are 11 stitches of separation between them.

D: Place it 2 cm (0.8 inch) below “A” spot.

Thread a tapestry needle with dark-brown yarn. Push the needle into “A” spot and through inside go up to “B” spot (use the diagonal line formed by the increases as guide), then through outside go back to “A”. Repeat this procedure 4 times.

Then, from “A” spot through inside go up to “C” spot (use the diagonal line formed by the increases as guide) and through outside go back to “A”. Repeat this procedure 4 times.

From “A” spot through inside go down to “D” spot and through outside go back to “A”. Repeat this procedure 4 times. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.



Eyes:

You'll need to crochet all these pieces twice.

Eyeball:

White color:

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Switch to beige color:

Rnd 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them with stuffing.

Pupil (black color):

In a double adjustable ring crochet: 2 single crochet, 3 half double crochet, 2 single crochet (7 stitches)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyelids (beige color):

Start with a double adjustable ring:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: Fold in half the circle and join the borders with a single crochet row (12 stitches)

Eyes' assemble: On the front side of the eyeballs (White zone) sew the pupils. With white yarn embroider a point of light on each pupil.

Sew the eyes on the face above round 29 of the muzzle and leaving 2 or 3 stitches of distance between them. Then place the eyelids overhead and a little bit above the eyes and sew them with invisible stitches.



Ears:

The ears consist in 2 parts: a beige internal piece and a White external piece.

Internal piece (beige color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors

External piece (White color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Without cutting the yarn off, face both pieces by their wrong sides and join their borders together with a single crochet row.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fold the ears in half and sew the borders together for 4 stitches in order to give them their shape. Then sew the ears to both sides of the head, a bit above

the union between the top of the head and muzzle.



Body (White color):

This piece is crocheted from bottom to top, interspersing single crochet rounds (odd rounds) and loop stitch rounds (pair rounds). Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 loop stitches in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: *8 loop stitch, 2 loop stitch in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11: *9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (66 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 18: Crochet these rounds without increases interspersing single crochet rounds (odd rounds) and loop stitch rounds (pair rounds).

Rnd 19: *31 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (64 stitches).

Rnd 20: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 21: *14 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 22: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 23: *13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times

(56 stitches).

Rnd 24: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 25: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (52 stitches).

Rnd 26: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 27: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 28: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 29: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (44 stitches).

Rnd 30: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 31: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 32: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 33: *18 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (38 stitches).

Rnd 34: Loops stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 35: *17 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (36 stitches).

Rnd 36: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 37: *16 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (34 stitches).

Rnd 38: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 39: *15 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (32 stitches).

Rnd 40: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 41: *14 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (30 stitches).

Rnd 42: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 43: *13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (28 stitches).

Rnd 44: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 45: *12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (26 stitches).

Rnd 46: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 47: *11 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* twice (24 stitches).

Rnd 48: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Fill the body with stuffing leaving the neck area very soft. Close the body's opening with a loop stitch row (12 stitches).

Sew the body to the head over the union between the top of the head and muzzle.



Back legs (Make 2):

Beige color:

Each back leg is crocheted in a single piece from bottom to top, starting from the foot sole. You'll have to start stuffing these pieces while you're crocheting them. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: *6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: *7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 10: *8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch through back loops only.

Rnd 12 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: 18 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 20 single crochet, 1 decrease, 18 single crochet (58 stitches)

Rnd 16: 17 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 20 single crochet, 1 decrease, 17 single crochet (56 stitches)

Rnd 17: 16 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 20 single crochet, 1 decrease, 16 single crochet (54 stitches)

Rnd 18: 15 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 20 single crochet, 1 decrease, 15 single crochet (52 stitches)

Rnd 19: 14 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 20 single crochet, 1 decrease, 14 single crochet (50 stitches)

Rnd 20: 13 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 2 decreases, 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 13 single crochet (46 stitches)

Rnd 21: 12 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 7 single crochet, 2 decreases, 7 single crochet, 1 decrease, 12 single crochet (42 stitches)

Rnd 22: 12 single crochet, *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)* repeat from *to* 6 times, 12 single crochet (36 stitches)

Rnd 23: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 24 to 43: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 44: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Switch to White color. Since this round you'll start interspersing single crochet rounds (pair rounds) and loop stitch rounds (odd rounds). In order to get the loops in the front side of the leg, turn around the work and start crocheting with the wrong side facing to you:

Rnd 45 to 51: Crochet these rounds without increases interspersing single crochet rounds (pair rounds) and loop stitch rounds (odd rounds).

Rnd 52: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 53: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 54: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 55: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 56: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 57: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 58: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 59: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 60: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last row and pull tightly to close. Sew the back legs to each side of the body in the following way:

First, from the centre of the body's bottom measure 3.2 inches to one side and mark the spot with a colored sewing pin. Repeat this procedure for the other side. Then thread a tapestry needle with white yarn, make a stitch on the inner side of the back leg and pass the needle through the body from side to side on the marks made with the colored sewing pins. Do the same for the other back leg and remove the colored sewing pins. Pull tightly in order to get the back legs joined to the body. Repeat this procedure a couple of times in order to keep this union firm. This sort of couture will allow the sheep to seat without problems, but if you prefer you can use plastic joints.

Thread a tapestry needle with dark-brown yarn (put yarn double) and make long stitches from each

foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little hard and making a knot to keep it firm, as in the final project.



Forelegs (Make 2):

Beige color:

Each foreleg is crocheted in a single piece from bottom to top. You'll have to start stuffing these pieces while you're crocheting them. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet stitches.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *17 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (38 stitches).

Rnd 8: *18 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (40 stitches).

Rnd 9: *19 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (42 stitches).

Rnd 10: *13 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 11: *14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 3 times (48 stitches).

Rnd 12 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *10 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (44 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *9 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 9 times (27 stitches).

Rnd 22 to 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to White color. Since this row you'll start interspersing single crochet rounds (odd rounds) and loop stitch rounds (pair rounds). In order to get the loops in the front side of the foreleg, turn around the work and start crocheting with the wrong side facing to you:

Rnd 42 to 48: Crochet these rounds without increases interspersing single crochet rounds (odd rounds) and loop stitch rounds (pair rounds).

Rnd 49: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 50: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 51: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 52: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 53: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 54: Loop stitch in each stitch from last round.

Rnd 55: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the tapestry needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last row and pull tightly to close.

From the union between the head and body measure down 2 inches and mark the spot with a colored sewing pin. Do the same for the other side. Over this spots you'll sew the forelegs using the same procedure used before for sewing the back legs.

Then thread a tapestry needle with dark-brown yarn (put yarn double) and mark the forelegs as in final project.

Tail (White color):

This piece is crocheted interspersing single crochet rounds (odd rounds) and loop stitch rounds (pair rounds). Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 loop stitches in each stitch from last round (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4 to 11: Crochet without increases.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Do not fill it with stuffing. Sew the tail to the bottom of the back side of the body as in the final project.



Ending details:

Sew together the top of the head and muzzle by their openings in order to assemble the head. Then with dark-brown yarn embroider the nose into a “Y” shape.

To assemble the eyes, first on the front side of the eyeballs (White zone) sew the pupils and then with white yarn embroider a point of light on each pupil.

Sew the eyes on the face above round 29 of the muzzle and leaving 2 or 3 stitches of distance between them. Then place the eyelids overhead and a little bit above the eyes and sew them with invisible stitches.

Fold the ears in half and sew the borders together for 4 stitches in order to give them their shape. Then sew the ears to both sides of the head, a bit above the union between the top of the head and muzzle.

Sew the body to the head over the union between the top of the head and muzzle.

Sew the back legs to each side of the body in the following way:

First, from the centre of the body’s bottom measure 3.2 inches to one side and mark the spot with a colored sewing pin. Repeat this procedure for the other side. Then thread a tapestry needle with white yarn, make a stitch on the inner side of the back leg and pass the needle through the body from side to side on the marks made with the colored sewing pins. Do the same for the other back leg and remove the colored sewing pins. Pull tightly in order to get the back legs joined to the body.

Repeat this procedure a couple of times in order to keep this union firm. This sort of couture will allow the sheep to seat without problems, but if you prefer you can use plastic joints. Thread a tapestry needle with dark-brown yarn (put yarn double) and make long stitches from each foot's bottom to the top, pulling a little hard and making a knot to keep it firm, as in the final project.

From the union between the head and body measure down 2 inches and mark the spot with a colored sewing pin. Do the same for the other side. Over this spots you'll sew the forelegs using the same procedure used before for sewing the back legs.

Then thread a tapestry needle with dark-brown yarn (put yarn double) and mark the forelegs as in final project.

Sew the tail to the bottom of the back side of the body.
