
Cynder, The Dragon

Materials

Dk or sports acrylic yarn in the following colors: purple, cherry red, lilac, grey, black, white and green.

C hook (2.5 mm), a tapestry needle, stuffing, colored sewing pins and scissors.

Stitches used in the project

Double adjustable ring, chain stitch, single crochet, half double crochet and 3 chain picot stitch.

Finished Size

11.5 inches tall

10 inches long



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Realization

Head and chest (purple color):

The head and chest are crocheted in a single piece from top to bottom and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.



To avoid a hole at the beginning of your project, you need to start it with a double adjustable ring (loop twice the yarn on your finger and when you finish the round pull the remaining yarn to close the hole):

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch (12 stitches).

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 6: 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 7: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 8: 2 single crochet, *2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (48 stitches).

Rnd 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: 3 single crochet, * 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (54 stitches).

Rnd 11 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches)

Rnd 22 & 23: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 24: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 25 & 26: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 27: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 28: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 29: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 30 to 38: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 39: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 40: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 42: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 43: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 44: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (48 stitches).

Rnd 45: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 46: 3 single crochet, * 2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (54 stitches).

Rnd 47: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 48: *2 single crochet in first stitch, 8 single crochet* repeat from *to* 6 times (60 stitches).

Rnd 49 to 52: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 53: *8 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (54 stitches).

Rnd 54: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 55: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (48 stitches)

Rnd 56: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 57: *6 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 58: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 59: *5 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (36 stitches).

Rnd 60: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 61: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 62: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 63: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 64: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 65: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Abdomen and tail (purple color):

The abdomen and tail are crocheted in a single piece, from back to front and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 13: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 14 to 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (21 stitches).

Rnd 18 to 20: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 21: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 22 to 24: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 25: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 7 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (27 stitches).

Rnd 26 to 28: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 29: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 30: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (36 stitches).

Rnd 31: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (42 stitches).

Rnd 32: 2 single crochet,*2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 5 times, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet (48 stitches).

Rnd 33 to 38: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 39: *14 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (45 stitches).

Rnd 40 & 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 42: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (40 stitches).

Rnd 43 to 45: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the abdomen to the chest by its opening, placing it between rounds 42 and 57 of the chest and adding more stuffing if required.



Muzzle and ventral piece:

With **purple** yarn work a foundation chain of 5 stitches (do not close them into a circle) and work around:



Rnd 1: 4 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch (14 stitches).

Rnd 2: 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 5 single crochet, 2 single

crochet in next stitch twice (18 stitches).

Rnd 3: 7 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 4 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (24 stitches).

Rnd 4: 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 9 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (28 stitches).

Rnd 5: 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 2 single crochet (32 stitches).

Rnd 6 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Continue crocheting for another 2 stitches after finishing round 9. Then switch to cherry red color and start crocheting back and forth:

Row 1: 8 single crochet.

Row 2 to 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 8: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (10 stitches).

Row 9: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (12 stitches).

Row 10: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (14 stitches).

Row 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 12: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (16 stitches).

Row 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 14: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 12 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (18 stitches).

Row 15: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 16: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 14 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (20 stitches).

Row 17 to 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 28: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 14 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (18 stitches).

Row 29: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 30: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 12 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (16 stitches).

Row 31: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 32: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 10 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (14 stitches).

Row 33: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 34: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (12 stitches).

Row 35 to 41: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 42: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (14 stitches).

Row 43: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 44: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 10 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (16 stitches).

Row 45 to 49: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 50: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 10 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (14 stitches).

Row 51: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 52: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 8 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (12 stitches).

Row 53: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 54: 4 single crochet, 2 decreases (2 single crochet closed together twice), 4 single crochet (10 stitches).

Row 55 & 56: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 57: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 4 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (8 stitches).

Row 58: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 59: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 2 single crochet, 1 decrease, 1 single crochet (6 stitches).

Row 60 to 64: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 65: 1 single crochet, 2 decreases (2 single crochet closed together twice), 1 single crochet (4 stitches).

Row 66 to 70: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 71: 1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together), 1 single crochet (3 stitches).

Row 72 to 74: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 75: 1 double decrease (3 single crochet closed together) (1 stitch).

Row 76: 1 single crochet.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Fill the muzzle with stuffing. With sewing pins, place the superior border of the muzzle under round 21 of the head and then, extend the ventral piece across the whole inferior part of the body, till the tail's tip. Sew around with invisible stitches.



Nostrils (purple color):

Make 2. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch (10 stitches)

Join the borders together with a single crochet row of 5 stitches.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the nostrils to the muzzle by their curved edge, placing them between rounds 5 and 8 of the muzzle and leaving 2 stitches of distance between them (on round 5).

Choker (grey color):

Work a foundation chain of 30 stitches, wrap it round the dragon's neck and join its endings with a slip stitch. Then, work 2 single crochet rounds on it. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Tail ring (grey color):

Work a foundation chain of 24 stitches, wrap it round the dragon's tail and join its endings with a slip stitch. Then, work 2 single crochet rounds on it. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyes:

Crochet all pieces twice.

Eyeball (white color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet

Rnd 2: 1 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (10 stitches).

Rnd 3: 2 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet (14 stitches).

Rnd 4: 3 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 3 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet (18 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Iris (green color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch (12 stitches)

Rnd 3: *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Pupil (black color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 5 single crochet

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch (10 stitches)

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Eyelid (purple color):

Work a foundation chain of 14 stitches and on them, work 2 single crochet rows.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew the eyeballs to both sides of the muzzle, diagonally. On them, sew the irises first and then the pupils. With white yarn embroider a dot on each pupil in order to mark the light reflection.





Place the eyelids surrounding the superior border of the eyeballs, with one of their endings over the superior border of the muzzle and sew them.



With lilac yarn embroider the forehead details and dots under both eyes. With black yarn embroider the mouth on the muzzle.

Horns:

Crochet all horns twice.

Horn A:

White color. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (10 stitches)

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (12 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 9: *5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* twice (14 stitches).

Rnd 10 to 12: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to purple color:

Rnd 13 to 17: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Horn B:

White color. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches)

Rnd 6 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to purple color:

Rnd 10 to 13: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.

Horn C:

White color. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 5: *3 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches)

Rnd 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to purple color:

Rnd 7 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill with stuffing.



Sew the horns to the head by their openings, in decreasing size order from the centre of the head to the sides, as you can see in the final project.

Forelegs (Make 2):

The forelegs are worked from toes to top and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Toes:

Crochet 3 toes per foreleg.

Grey color. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to purple color:

Rnd 4: *3 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches)

Rnd 5 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Crochet the other 2 toes following the above instructions. Once you finished crocheting the 3rd toe, do not cut the yarn off. Place 1 toe next to each other and sew them together by 3 stitches. Then, continue crocheting the foot around the toes, starting on the side of the last toe:

Rnd 1: 27 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

After finishing round 7, continue crocheting for another 5 stitches and then, start working the heel back and forth:

Row 1: 4 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (5 stitches).

Row 2: 5 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (6 stitches).

Row 3: 6 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (7 stitches).

Row 4: 7 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (8 stitches).

Row 5: 8 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (9 stitches).

Row 6: 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (10 stitches).

Row 7: 10 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (11 stitches).

Row 8: 11 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (12 stitches).

Row 9: 12 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (13 stitches).

Row 10: 13 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (14 stitches).

From next round, continue crocheting the leg in spiral:

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 14: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 15: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 16: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 17: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 5 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 18 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 26: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 27: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 28: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 29: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 30: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 31: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Bracelets (grey color):

Make 2.

Work a foundation chain of 24 stitches, wrap it round the dragon's foreleg and join its endings with a slip stitch.

Then, work 2 single crochet rounds on it. Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Hindlegs (Make 2):

The hindlegs are worked from toes to top and have to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Toes:

Crochet 3 toes per hindleg.

Grey color. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Switch to purple color:



Rnd 4: *3 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches)

Rnd 5 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. Crochet the other 2 toes following the above instructions. Once you finished crocheting the 3rd toe, do not cut the yarn off. Place 1 toe next to each other and sew them together by 3 stitches. Then, continue crocheting the foot around the toes, starting on the side of the last toe:

Rnd 1: 27 single crochet.

Rnd 2 to 6: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 7: *7 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 8: Single crochet in each stitch.

After finishing round 7, continue crocheting for another 5 stitches and then, start working the heel back and forth:

Row 1: 4 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (5 stitches).

Row 2: 5 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (6 stitches).

Row 3: 6 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (7 stitches).

Row 4: 7 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (8 stitches).

Row 5: 8 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (9 stitches).

Row 6: 9 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (10 stitches).

Row 7: 10 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (11 stitches).

Row 8: 11 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (12 stitches).

Row 9: 12 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (13 stitches).

Row 10: 13 single crochet, 1 slip stitch (14 stitches).

From next round, continue crocheting the leg in spiral:

Rnd 1: 24 single crochet.

Rnd 2 & 3: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 4: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 4 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 5 to 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 10: *4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 4 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 13 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 19: *4 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (25 stitches).

Rnd 20: Single crochet in each stitch.



Rnd 21: *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (20 stitches).

Rnd 22: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 23: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 5 times (10 stitches).

Rnd 24: 5 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 5 times) (5 stitches).

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors. With the sewing needle sew up and down the yarn around each stitch from last round and pull tightly to close.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the torax and the hindlegs to both sides of the abdomen.

Wings (Make 2):

The wings consist in 3 membranes and 2 pillars.

Membranes (cherry red color):

Crochet 3 membranes per wing.

Work 2 chain stitches and in the 2nd chain from the hook crochet:

Row 1: 1 single crochet.

Row 2: 3 single crochet.

Row 3: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (4 stitches).

Row 4: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch twice, 1 single crochet (6 stitches).

Row 5: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 6: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (8 stitches).

Row 7: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 8: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (10 stitches).

Row 9: Single crochet in each stitch.

Row 10: 1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet (12 stitches).

Row 11 to 18: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Pillar A (purple color):

Crochet 1 pillar "A" per wing.

The pillar "A" has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: 6 single crochet.

Rnd 3 to 25: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Pillar B:

Crochet 1 pillar "B" per wing.

The pillar "B" has to be filled with stuffing as you go.

Grey color. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 6: Through **back loops only** crochet *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 7: 6 decreases (2 single crochet closed together 6 times) (6 stitches).

Switch to purple color:

Rnd 8 to 11: Single crochet in each stitch.

Rnd 12: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (7 stitches)

Rnd 13: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (8 stitches)

Rnd 14: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (9 stitches)

Rnd 15: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (10 stitches)

Rnd 16: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (11 stitches)

Rnd 17: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (12 stitches)

Rnd 18: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (13 stitches)

Rnd 19: 2 single crochet in first stitch, 1 single crochet in each stitch (14 stitches)

Rnd 20 to 37: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot and cut the yarn with scissors.

Sew pillar "A" to pillar "B" by its opening, between rounds 8 and 12.

Take 3 membranes and place them 1 next to each other, with their vertices towards up.

Then, with purple yarn join them together by crocheting a single crochet round, across the front and back side of the wing, starting on the base and making a 3 chain picot after finishing the union.



Once you have joined the 3 membranes together, sew them to pillars “A” and “B”, placing their vertices under the union between the pillars.

Sew pillar “B” by its opening to the back side of the torax.

Tail tip (grey color):

Into a double adjustable ring crochet:



Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 2 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 4: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 3 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (15 stitches).

Rnd 5: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 4 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 6: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 5 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (21 stitches).

Rnd 7: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 6 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 8: Through **back loops only**, crochet *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 9: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Rnd 10: Through **front loops only**, crochet *1 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 times).

Rnd 11: *2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 12: *3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next stitch*, repeat from *to* 6 times (30 stitches).

Rnd 13: Through **back loops only**, crochet *3 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (24 stitches).

Rnd 14: *2 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (18 stitches).

Rnd 15: *1 single crochet, 1 decrease (2 single crochet closed together)*, repeat from *to* 6 times (12 stitches).

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill it lightly with stuffing.

Sew the tail tip to the tip of the tail.

Spurs (grey color):

Make 4. Into a double adjustable ring crochet:

Rnd 1: 6 half double crochet.

Rnd 2: *2 single crochet in next stitch, 1 single crochet* repeat from *to* 3 times (9 stitches)

Rnd 3 & 4: Single crochet in each stitch.

Make a knot, cut the yarn with scissors and fill them with stuffing. Sew 1 spur on each leg, over the top of the heels.

Ending details

Sew the abdomen to the chest by its opening, placing it between rounds 42 and 57 of the chest and adding more stuffing if required.



Fill the muzzle with stuffing. With sewing pins, place the superior border of the muzzle under round 21 of the head and then, extend the ventral piece across the whole inferior part of the body, till the tail's tip. Sew around with invisible stitches.

Sew the nostrils to the muzzle by their curved edge, placing them between rounds 5 and 8 of the muzzle and leaving 2 stitches of distance between them (on round 5).

Sew the eyeballs to both sides of the muzzle, diagonally. On them, sew the irises first and then the pupils. With white yarn embroider a dot on each pupil in order to mark the light

reflection.

Place the eyelids surrounding the superior border of the eyeballs, with one of their endings over the superior border of the muzzle and sew them.

With lilac yarn embroider the forehead details and dots under both eyes. With black yarn embroider the mouth on the muzzle.

Sew the horns to the head by their openings, in decreasing size order from the centre of the head to the sides, as you can see in the final project.

Sew the forelegs to both sides of the torax and the hindlegs to both sides of the abdomen.

Sew pillar "B" of the wings by its opening to the back side of the torax.

Sew the tail tip to the tip of the tail.

Sew 1 spur on each leg, over the top of the heels.
